



Log Cabin Throw

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

38" x 38"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Bulky (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 87yds/80m)

- #1068-01 Snow (A) – 6 balls
- #1068-03 Fog Gray (B) – 4 balls
- #1068-04 Steel Grey (C) – 2 balls
- #1068-13 Royal Blue (D) – 2 balls
- #1068-09 Magenta (E) – 2 balls
- #1068-07 Coral (F) – 2 balls
- #1068-15 Aqua (G) – 2 balls

Needles: Two US Size 11 (8 mm) 32" Circular needles + 1 extra straight needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts x 20 rows = 4" in garter stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Log Cabin Square

With MC and a circular needle, cast on 9 sts.

Knit 15 rows.

Cut MC, join CC1.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece 90° counter-clockwise, pick up and knit 1 st in each ridge along edge – 13 sts on needle.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 12 sts – 13 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 16 sts – 17 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Cut yarn and join MC.

Rotate piece, pick up and knit 16 sts – 17 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 20 sts – 21 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 20 sts – 21 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 24 sts – 25 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Cut yarn and join CC2.

Rotate piece, pick up and knit 24 sts – 25 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 28 sts – 29 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 28 sts – 29 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off leaving last st on needle. Rotate piece, pick up and knit 32 sts – 33 sts total.

Knit 7 rows.

Bind off.

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3-needle bind-off: Hold 2 needles with stitches in your left hand, next to each other, hold the third, empty, needle in your right hand. Insert the right needle through the first st on both of the left needles and knit sts together, *insert the right needle through the next st on both of the next needles and knit sts together, pass first st on right needle over second; rep from * until all sts are bound off.

THROW

Make 3 Log Cabin Squares using D for MC, C for CC1, A for CC2.

Make 2 Log Cabin Squares using E for MC, A for CC1, B for CC2.

Make 2 Log Cabin Squares using F for MC, A for CC1, B for CC2.

Make 2 Log Cabin Squares using G for MC, C for CC1, A for CC2.

FINISHING

Assembly

Squares are joined using a 3-needle bind-off from the RS of the fabric. This creates a decorative ridge between the squares.

Using the Assembly Diagram as a guide, join as follows. With first circular needle and A, pick up and knit 33 sts across the top edge of the bottom 3 squares – 99 sts total.

With second circular needle and A, pick up and knit 33 sts across the bottom edge of the center 3 squares – 99 sts total.

Holding the 2 circular needles in left hand with WS together, use the straight needle as the 3rd needle and bind off using the **3-needle bind off** in A.

Following the same technique, join the top edge of the center row to the bottom edge of the top row of squares.

Then join the vertical seams in the same fashion.

Edging

With a circular needle and A, pick up and knit 101 sts across one edge of the throw (33 sts across each square and 1 st in each bind-off ridge). Knit 1 row. Bind off leaving the last st on the needle.

*Rotate, pick up and knit 102 sts across the next edge of the throw (33 sts across each square, 1 st in each bind-off ridge, and 1 st in edging). Knit 1 row. Bind off leaving the last st on the needle.

Repeat from * once more.

Rotate, pick up and knit 103 sts across the last edge of the throw (33 sts across each square, 1 st in each bind-off ridge, and 1 st in edging at both ends). Knit 1 row. Bind off.

Weave in ends.



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Abbreviations

- CC contrasting color
- MC main color
- rep repeat(ing)
- RS right side
- sl st slip stitch
- st(s) stitch(es)
- WS wrong side
