## SIZES

Hat: Baby (Child, Adult S, Adult M, Adult L)
Mittens: Child (Adult S, Adult M, Adult L)
Cowl: Adult One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

## Hat

Circumference: $143 / 4$ ( $171 / 4,181 / 4,201 / 2,223 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$
Height: $7114(81 / 4,91 / 2,10,11)^{\prime \prime}$ (not including pompom)

## Mittens

Circumference: 6 ( $63 / 4,71 / 2,81 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$
Length: $7112(83 / 4,9114,10)$ "

## Cowl

Circumference: 24"
Height: 12"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$ DK Merino Blend (55\% Superwash Merino, 45\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100 g, 273 yds/250m)

- MC: 2006-04 Ecru - 3 balls
- C1: 2006-05 Heather Gray - 1 ball
- C2: 2006-09 Ice Blue - 1 ball
- C3: 2006-20 Cadet - 1 ball
- C4: 2006-24 Deep Navy - 1 ball
- C5: 2006-07 Berry - 1 ball
- C6: 2006-15 Carnation - 1 ball
- C7: 2006-16 Mustard - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 5 ( 3.75 mm ) and US Size 4 ( 3.5 mm ) 16" circular needle and set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn, extra-large pompom maker ( $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, optional)

## GAUGE

21 sts $\times 27$ rnds $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in St st in the rnd with larger needle.

## Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Rib (even number of sts)
Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.
Stripe Pattern (any number of sts)
Rnd 1: With C1, knit.
Rnds 2-4: With MC, knit.
Rnd 5: With C2, knit.
Rnds 6-8: With MC, knit.
Rnd 9: With C3, knit.
Rnds 10-12: With MC, knit.
Rnd 13: With C4, knit.
Rnds 14-16: With MC, knit.
Rnd 17: With C5, knit.
Rnds 18-20: With MC, knit.
Rnd 21: With C6, knit.
Rnds 22-24: With MC, knit.
Rnd 25: With C7, knit.
Rnds 26-28: With MC, knit.
Rep Rnds 1-28 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

The Hat, Cowl and Mittens are worked from the bottom up in the round.

## HAT

With smaller needle and MC, cast on 78 (90, 96, 108, 120) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in 1x1 Rib until piece meas $1 \frac{1}{4}\left(1 \frac{1}{2}, 2,2,2\right)$ " from cast-on edge. Switch to larger needle and work even in Stripe Pattern until piece meas $53 / 4(63 / 4,8,81 / 2,91 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on edge or to desired height less $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Crown Shaping

(Note: When the stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle, switch to dpns.)
Maintain Stripe Pattern throughout this section
Rnd 1: *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end - 13 (15, 16, 18, 20) sts dec'd, $65(75,80,90,100)$ sts rem.

Even Rnds 2-10: Knit.
Rnd 3: *K3, k2tog; rep from * to end - 52 (60, 64, 72, 80) sts rem.

Rnd 5: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end - 39 (45, 48, 54, 60) sts rem.

Rnd 7: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 26 (30, 32, 36, 40) sts rem.

Rnd 9: *K2tog; rep from * to end - $13(15,16,18,20)$ sts rem.
Rnd 11: *K2tog; rep from * to last $1(1,0,0,0)$ st, k1 $(1,0,0,0)-7(8,8,9,10)$ sts rem.
Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## MITTENS

## Cuff

With MC and smaller dpns cast on $32(36,40,44)$ sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in $1 \times 1$ Rib until piece meas $11 / 2$ (2, $2,2)$ " from cast-on edge or to desired length.
Switch to larger dpns.

## Thumb Gusset

Rnd 1: Knit to last 2 sts, pm (Gusset marker), m1, k1, m1-3 Gusset sts.
Rnds 2-3: Knit.
Rnd 4: Knit to m, sm, m1, knit to next m, m12 Gusset sts inc'd.
Rep last 3 rnds, $4(5,6,7)$ more times $13(15,17,19)$ Gusset sts.

Gusset Separation Rnd: Work in est'd patt to Gusset marker, remove marker, sl next $13(15,17,19)$ sts to stitch holder or waste yarn for thumb, cast on 3 sts to bridge the gap, work in patt to end $-34(38,42,46)$ sts.
Next Rnd: Work in patt to 1 st before cast on sts, ssk, k2tog, knit to end - $32(36,40,44)$ sts.

## Hand

Work even in patt until piece meas $61 / 2(71 / 2,73 / 4,8)$ " from cast-on edge.

## Shape Top

Rnd 1: K1, ssk, k10 (12, 14, 16), k2tog, k1, pm, k1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - $28(32,36,40)$ sts.

## Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: *K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1; rep from * once more -4 sts dec'd.
Rep last 2 rnds $2(3,4,5)$ more time(s) - 16 sts rem. Rep Rnd 3, 2 more times -8 sts rem. Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## Thumb

Return $13(15,17,19)$ held Gusset sts to dpns and join yarn, maintaining Stripe Pattern.
Rnd 1: Knit to end, pick up and knit 3 sts at cast on edge of thumb opening - $16(18,20,22)$ sts.
Rnd 2: Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, ssk last st of rnd with 1 st st of next rnd - $14(16,18,20)$ sts.
Work even in patt until Thumb meas $1\left(1 \frac{1}{2}, 13 / 4,2\right)$ ".
Dec Rnd 1: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to last $2(1,0,2)$ $10(12,13,15)$ sts.
Dec Rnd 2: *K2tog; rep from * to last $0(0,1,1)$ st, k0 $(0,1,1)-5(6,7,8)$ sts.
Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

## COWL

With MC and smaller circular needle, cast on 126 sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in 1x1 Rib until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge. Switch to larger needles and work in Stripe Pattern until piece meas 10 " from cast-on edge. Switch to smaller needles and MC, work even in 1x1 Rib for 2". Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Make and attach pompom to top of Hat, if desired.

m1 make 1 (1 st inc'd)
m1R make 1 stitch, right leaning
m1L make 1 stitch, left leaning
meas measures
p purl
p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt pattern
pm place marker
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
sl slip
sm slip marker
ssk slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
st(s) stitch(es)
St st Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
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
