## SIZE

One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 12"

**Length:** 52" (not including fringe)

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday® DK Merino Blend** (55% Superwas Merino Wool, 45% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 273yds/250m)

- 2006-17 Olive – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

16 dc x 9 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single, double crochet and half double crochet stitches.
- Working the back loop.
- Double crochet 3 together.
- Working in third loop of half double crochet.
- Adding fringe.

## STITCH GUIDE

### 3<sup>rd</sup> lp of hdc (Third Loop Half Double Crochet):

Work into the '3<sup>rd</sup> lp' of the hdc st. The horizontal line at the back of the st is the 3<sup>rd</sup> lp. Working into this lp creates a unique, ribbing effect.

## SCARF

Ch 52.

**Row 1:** 3 dc in 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hk (counts as dc and ch 1), \*sk 2 chs, 3 dc in next ch; rep from \* to last 3 chs, sk 2 chs, dc in last ch, turn.

**Rows 2-3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, \*sk 2 dc, dc in next st, ch 1, dc in first skipped st; rep from \*, ending with dc in last st, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), \*dc3tog, ch 2; rep from \*, ending with dc in last st, turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, \*sk next ch-2 sp, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in skipped ch-2 sp; rep from \*, ending with dc in last st, turn.

**Rows 7-20:** Rep Rows 5 and 6, 7 times.

**Row 21:** Ch 1 (not a st), hdc in each st and ch-1 sp across, turn.

**Row 22:** Ch 1, working in 3<sup>rd</sup> lp of hdc, hdc in each st across, turn.

**Row 23:** Ch 3, working in blo, dc in each each st across, turn.

**Row 24:** Ch 1, hdc in each st across.

**Rows 25-40:** Rep Rows 23 and 24, eight times. Rep Rows 7-40 until Scarf measures 52".

**Next 16 Rows:** Rep Rows 5-6 eight times.

**Last 3 rows:** Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Fringe

Cut 102 - 16" lengths of yarn. With 3 lengths held together, fold in half, pull center of lengths through st, pull end of lengths through center loop and pull tight. Rep evenly across end of scarf about ¾" apart. Trim evenly. Repeat for other end.

Weave in ends.

**blo** back loop only

**ch** chain

**dc** double crochet

**dc3tog** double crochet the next 3 sts together (2 sts dec)

**hdc** half double crochet

**hk** hook

**lp(s)** loop(s)

**rep** repeat

**sk** skip

**sp(s)** space(es)

**st(s)** stitch(es)
