Coming Up Roses Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48" Length: 48"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® DK (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 273 yds/250m

C1: 1107-19 Linen – 4 skeins
C2: 1107-55 Blush – 4 skeins
C3: 1107-54 Rose – 4 skeins

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) hook or size needed

to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" in patt Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Striped Linen Stitch (Multiple of 2 for foundation ch)

Foundation Row: With C1, Sc in 4th ch from hook, *ch 1, sk 1 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across, turn.

Row 1: With C2, ch 2, *sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * across, sc in last ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 2: With C3, as Row 1. Row 3: With C1, as Row 1. Rep Rows 1-3 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked in one piece from one end to the other. Carry colors along the edge of the Throw as you work, do not cut colors between stripes.

Throw

Ch 182.

Work **Striped Linen Stitch** until piece meas 48", ending with Row 3 of patt.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

chain ch meas measures patt pattern repeat(ing) rep reverse rev single crochet SC sk skip space sp

yarn over
