Cozy Headband

SIZES

Child (Adult S, Adult M, Adult L) Note: Headband should be approximately 2" less than the actual head circumference of the wearer.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Head Circumference: 18 (19, 20, 21)" Width: 4½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Anti-Pilling® Everyday® DK* (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 273yds/250m)

• 1107-56 Mustard – 1 ball **Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers

GAUGE

15 sc x 16 rows = 4" Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, slip stitch, and single crochet stitches.
- Working through the back loop.
- Seaming.

PATTERN NOTES

Headband is made flat in one piece. The ends are folded around one another and seamed to form the twist.

HEADBAND

Ch 69 (73, 77, 81). **Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn - 68 (72, 76, 80) sc. **Row 2:** Ch 1, sl st in blo of each st across, turn. **Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in blo of each st across, turn. Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures approximately 3½ (3¾, 4, 4¼)", ending with a Row 3.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

Place a removable stitch marker on the short edge of one side at the halfway point. Repeat for the other side. Hold the Headband with RS together. Fold one side up and around the other at the halfway point, sandwiching the other end and forming a "c". Then, fold the other side up and over the other folded side, forming a "reverse c". Using the long tail, whipstitch the ends together through all four layers.

Weave in ends.




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Seaming Diagram

Step 1: Fold in half so RS are facing. Place a marker at the halfway point of each end.



Step 2: Fold the ends around one another to form a C and a backwards C.



Step 3: Whipstitch together through all layers
