



SIZES

12 mos (2T, 4T, 6) (8, 10, 12) years
Shown in Size 8 years

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 23 (25¼, 27¼, 30¼) (31½, 33, 34½)"
Length: 12¼ (14¼, 16½, 18) (19½, 20¼, 21½)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® DK
(100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g,
230yds/210m)

- MC: 1107-59 Straw – 1 (2, 2, 3) (3, 3, 4) ball(s)
- CC1: 1107-29 Cloudy Day – 1 ball
- CC2: 1107-15 Peacock – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) and US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, locking stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn

GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle
Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit, purl and slip stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Increasing and decreasing.
- Working into rows below.
- Working extra wraps.

STITCH GUIDE

Chevron Stripes (multiple of 4+1 sts)

Row 1 (WS): With CC1, purl.

Row 2 (RS): With CC1, knit.

Row 3: With CC1, p2, *p1 wrapping yarn twice

around the needle, p3; rep from * to end, ending last rep with p2.

Row 4: With CC2, k2, *sl 1 wyib dropping extra wrap, k1, insert needle into next st 2 rows below and loosely pull up a loop, knit next st and pass loop over the st just knit, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 1 wyib dropping extra wrap, k2.

Row 5: With CC2, p2, *sl 1 wyif, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 1 wyif, p2.

Row 6: With CC2, knit.

Row 7: With CC2, p2, *p1 wrapping yarn twice around the needle, p3; rep from * to end, ending last rep with p2.

Rows 8-11: With CC1, rep Rows 4-7.
Rep Rows 4-11 for patt.

1X1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked flat from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. This Pullover is intended to fit with 3-5" positive ease.

PULLOVER

Back

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 65 (73, 77, 85) (89, 93, 97) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in **1X1 Rib** to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work in **1X1 Rib** to last st, p1.
Rep last 2 rows until piece meas 2 (2, 2, 2½)

(2½, 2½, 2½)". Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas 6½ (7¾, 9¼, 9½) (10¼, 10¾, 11½)" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a RS row. Cut MC and join CC1, work 19 (19, 19, 27) (27, 27, 27) rows

even in **Chevron Stripes** patt (approx. 2¾ (2¾, 2¾, 3¾) (3¾, 3¾, 3¾)”) ending having just worked a Row 11). Cut CCs and rejoin MC, work even in St st until piece meas 12¼ (14¼, 16½, 18) (19½, 20¼, 21½)” from cast-on edge, loosely bind off all sts.

Front

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 65 (73, 77, 85) (89, 93, 97) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in **1X1 Rib** to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work in **1X1 Rib** to last st, p1.

Rep last 2 rows until piece meas 2 (2, 2, 2½) (2½, 2½, 2½)”. Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas 6½ (7¾, 9¼, 9½) (10¼, 10¾, 11½)” from cast-on edge, end having just worked a RS row. Cut MC and join CC1, work 19 (19, 19, 27) (27, 27, 27) rows even in **Chevron Stripes** patt (approx. 2¾ (2¾, 2¾, 3¾) (3¾, 3¾, 3¾)”) ending having just worked a Row 11). Cut CCs and rejoin MC, work even in St st until piece meas 10¼ (12¼, 14½, 16) (16¾, 17½, 18¾)” from cast-on edge.

Neck Shaping

Row 1 (RS): K24 (28, 29, 33) (34, 36, 38) (left shoulder sts), bind off 17 (17, 19, 19) (19, 21, 21) sts, knit to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn – K24 (28, 29, 33) (34, 36, 38) right shoulder sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end — 1 st dec’d.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times — 4 sts dec’d, 19 (23, 24, 28) (30, 31, 33) sts rem.

Work 2 (2, 2, 2) (6, 6, 6) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Place held right shoulder sts on working needle and with RS facing, join working yarn.

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 — 1 st dec’d.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times — 4 sts dec’d, 19 (23, 24, 28) (30, 31, 33) sts rem.

Work 2 (2, 2, 2) (6, 6, 6) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Sleeves (make 2)

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 38 (40, 40, 40) (42, 44, 44) sts. Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 2”. Switch to larger needles work 10 (8, 4, 4) (4, 4, 2) rows even in St st.

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, work even in patt to last 3 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc’d.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every RS row 0 (0, 1, 3) (0, 0, 0) more time(s), every 4th row 1 (3, 12, 13) (15, 14, 15) time(s), and then every 6th row 3 (3, 0, 0) (1, 3, 4) time(s) — 8 (12, 26, 32) (32, 34, 38) sts inc’d, 48 (54, 68, 72) (74, 78, 82) sts total.

If necessary, work even until Sleeve meas 8½ (9¼, 10½, 11¾) (13¼, 14¼, 15¼)” from cast-on edge, loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew one shoulder seam, with mattress st.

Neck Edging

With smaller needles and MC, pick up and knit 64 (64, 68, 68) (74, 78, 78) sts along neck edge, approximately 1 st per bound off st and 3 sts to every 4 rows. Work

even in **1X1 Rib** until edging meas 1”, loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Sew other shoulder seam and Neck Edging. Place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Front and Back and Sleeves.

Weave in ends.
