## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 37 (403/4, 45, 483/4, 53, 563/4)"
Length: $251 / 4(2533 / 4,26,261 / 2,271 / 4,273 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$ DK (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 273yds/250m)

- MC: 1107-19 Linen - $5(5,6,6,7,8)$ balls
- CC1: 1107-51 Bright Blue - 1 ball
- CC2: 1107-48 Bright Green - 1 ball
- CC3: 1107-47 Highlighter - 1 ball
- CC4: 1107-50 Bright Pink - 1 ball
- CC5: 1107-49 Bright Orange - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 6 ( 4 mm ) straights, US Size 5
( 3.75 mm ) straights and 16 " or set of double point needles or size needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, locking stitch marker, stitch holder or waste yarn

## GAUGE

22 sts $\times 28$ rows $=4$ " in St st with larger needle Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

1X1 Rib Flat (multiple of 2 sts )
Row 1 (RS): K1, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 2 (WS): K1, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.
Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

1X1 Rib in the Rnd (multiple of 2 sts) Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Stripe Sequence (any multiple of sts, worked in St st)
Row 1 (RS): CC.
Rows 2, 3, 4: MC.
Row 5: CC.
Rows 6, 7, 8: MC.
Rep Rows 1-8 with each color in order (CC1, CC2, CC3, CC4, CC5), end last rep with CC5 on Row 5, 37 rows total.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. The neck edging is picked up and worked in the round after seaming.

## PULLOVER

Back
With smaller needles and MC, cast on 104 (114, 126, 136, 148, 156) sts. Work even in 1X1 Rib Flat until piece meas $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$. Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas $151 / 2(16,153 / 4,161 / 4,163 / 4,163 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on edge. Work Stripe Sequence and then work even in MC until piece meas $251 / 4(253 / 4$, 26, 261/2, 271/4, 273/4)" from cast on edge, bind off all sts.

## Neon Stripes Pullover

## Front

With smaller needles and MC, cast on 104 (114, 126, 136, 148, 156) sts. Work even in 1X1 Rib Flat until piece meas $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Switch to larger needles and work even in St st, until piece meas $151 / 2(16,153 / 4,161 / 4$, $163 / 4,163 / 4$ )" from cast-on edge. Work Stripe Sequence and then work $1^{\prime \prime}$ even in MC, end having just worked a WS row.

## Neck Shaping

Row 1 (RS): K43 (48, 53, 58, 64, 69), bind off 18 (18, 20, 20, 20, 20) sts, knit to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.
Row 2 (WS): Purl.
Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to end -1 st dec'd.
Next Row: Purl.
Rep these 2 rows $8(8,8,8,8,10)$ more times -8 ( 8 , $8,8,8,10)$ sts dec'd, $34(39,44,49,55,58)$ sts rem. Work $4(4,8,8,8,8)$ rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Place held sts on working needle and with RS facing, join MC.
Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1- 1 st dec'd. Next Row: Purl.
Rep these 2 rows $8(8,8,8,8,10)$ more times $-8(8$, $8,8,8,10)$ sts dec'd, $34(39,44,49,55,58)$ sts rem. Work $4(4,8,8,8,8)$ rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Sleeves (Make 2.)
With smaller needles and MC, cast on 48 (48, 48, 48,
52,52 ) sts. Work even in 1X1 Rib Flat until piece meas $21 / 2$ ". Switch to larger needles work $8(8,8,8,6,6,6)$ rows even in St st.

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, work even in patt to last 2 sts,
kfb, k1 - 2 sts inc'd.
All other rows: Work even in patt.
Rep Inc Row every RS row $0(0,0,0,0,4)$ more times, every $4^{\text {th }}$ row $0(8,17,25,25,25)$ times, and then every $6^{\text {th }}$ row $17(12,6,1,1,0)$ times $-34(40,46$, $52,52,58)$ sts inc'd, $84(90,96,102,106,112)$ sts total.
Work even until Sleeve meas 19½" from cast-on edge, bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Front and Back and Sleeves.

## Neck Edging

With circ or dpns and MC, pick up and knit 88 (88, 98, $98,98,108)$ sts, pm and join to work in the rnd. Work even in $\mathbf{1 x 1}$ Rib in the Rnd until edging meas $1 \frac{114}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$, bind off all sts in rib.

Weave in ends.
