



Riley Ribbed Cowl

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 50"

Width: 10"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® DK
(100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g; 273 yds/250)

- 1107-42 Rosewood – 2 balls (A)
- 1107-27 Dove – 2 balls (B)
- 1107-56 Mustard – 2 balls (C)
- 1107-15 Peacock – 2 balls (D)

Hook: US Size H/8 (5.0 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 hdc x 15 rows = 4" in Multicolor Rib

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Fpdc (front post double crochet): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Multicolor Rib (Multiples of 4)

Foundation Row (RS): With A, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn.

Row 1 (WS): With A, ch 2 (counts as a hdc here and throughout), sk the first st, hdc in each st across.

Change to B, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 3 hdc, *Fpdc in the next st 2 rows below, sc in each of the next 3 hdc; rep from * across, ending with Fpdc in the next st 2 rows below, sc in each of the next 2 hdc, sc in the top of the turning ch-2, turn.

Row 3: With B, rep Row 1. Change to C.

Row 4: With C, rep Row 2.

Row 5: With C, rep Row 1. Change to D.

Row 6: With D, rep Row 2.

Row 7: With D, rep Row 1. Change to A.

Row 8: With A, rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This cowl is worked flat longways and then seamed along the short side to make it a circular cowl. Always skip the hdc behind every Fpdc, never work that sc. Other than the very first time you work Row 2 of the **Multicolor Rib**, always Fpdc around the post 2 sts below, not into the st. To avoid weaving in as many ends, carry the yarn loosely up the side after each stripe.

COWL

With A, ch 192.

Work **Multicolor Rib** (Foundation Row - Row 8) once, then work Rows 1-8 four times. With A, work Rows 1-2 once (43 rows total).

Fasten off.

Leave a tail long enough for seaming.

FINISHING

With tapestry needle, sew the short ends of the cowl together.

Weave in ends.
