

Tilted Granny Pullover

## SIZES

Adult XS/S (S/M, M, L, L/1X, 1X/2X) (2X, 3X, $3 X / 4 X, 4 X / 5 X, 5 X)$
Shown in XS/S size.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 37 (40, 43, 46, 49, 52) (55, 58, 61, 64, 67)"

Length: 19 (19, 19, 20½, 20½, 20½) (22, 22, 22, 23122, 23122)"
Pullover is intended to fit with approximately 2-6" of positive ease.

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Anti-Pilling ${ }^{\circledR}$ Everyday ${ }^{\circledR}$ DK (100\% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 273yds/250m)

- MC: 1107-07 Garnet - $2(2,3,3,4,4)$ (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) balls
- CC1: 1107-02 Cream - $1(1,2,2,2,2)$ (3, 3, 3, 3, 3) balls(s)
- CC2: 1107-27 Dove - $1(1,2,2,2,2)(3$, 3, 3, 3, 3) ball(s)
Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) or sizes needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

$15 \mathrm{dc} \times 71 / 2$ rnds $=4^{\prime \prime}$
15 sts x 17 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Moss St
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single, half, and double crochet stitches.
- Working flat and in turned rounds.
- Increasing and decreasing.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.
- Magic Ring.


## STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6 " tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Beg dc3tog (beginning double crochet 3
together): Ch 3, dc2tog over next 2 sts - 2 sts dec'd.

Moss Stitch (even number of sts)
Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as sc + ch 1), sk first 2 sts, *sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to last 2 , sc in last 2, turn.
Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as sc + ch 1), *sc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk sc; rep from * to last 2, sc in last 2, turn.
Rep Row 2 for patt.

## Square Motif

Begin with Magic Ring.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, *ch 3, 3 dc in ring; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, join with hdc to top of beg ch-3, turn -3 dc each side.
Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, dc in next 3 dc, *(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc ) in ch-3 sp, dc in next 3 dc ; rep from * 2 more times, 2 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 1, join with hdc to top of beg ch-3, turn - 7 dc each side.
Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, dc in each dc to ch-3 sp, *( 2 dc , ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-3 sp , dc in each dc to ch-3 sp; rep from * 2 more times, 2 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 1, join with hdc to top of beg ch-3, turn - 11 dc each side. Rep Rnd 3 for patt.

## Color Sequence

1 row/rnd CC1
1 row/rnd CC2
1 row/rnd MC
Rep these 3 rows/rounds for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

Front and Back square Motifs are worked in turned rounds from the center out until the maximum height is reached. Then, left and right sides are worked separately to reach maximum width and finish off the corners. Sleeves are made up of Motifs

## PULLOVER

Back
Beg with CC1 and Stripe Sequence, make a Square
Motif that is $11(11,11,12,12,12)(13,13,13,14,14)$ rnds $-43(43,43,47,47,47)(51,51,51,55,55)$ dc along each side.

## Left Side

Note: Continue alternating colors according to Stripe

## Sequence.

Row 1: Beg dc3tog with first leg in corner sp , dc in each dc to ch-3 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to 2 sts before ch-3 sp, dc3tog with last leg in ch-3 sp, turn - $44(44,44,48,48,48)(52,52,52,56$, 56) dc along each side.

- (S/M, M, L, L/1X, 1X/2X) (2X, 3X, 3X/4X, 4X/5X, 5X) Sizes Only:
Row 2: Beg dc3tog, dc in each dc to ch-3 sp, ( 2 dc , ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to last 3 dc , dc3tog, turn - $-(44,44,48,48,48)(52,52,52,56,56)$ dc along each side.

Rep Row 2, - (0, 1, 1, 2, 3) (3, 4, 5, 5, 6) more times.

## All Sizes:

## Upper Left Back

Row 1: Beg dc3tog, dc in each dc to 2 sts before ch-3 sp, dc3tog, turn - $41(41,41,45,45,45)(49,49,49$, 53,53 ) dc rem along each side.
Row 2: Beg dc3tog, dc in each dc to last 3, dc3tog, turn - 4 sts dec'd, $37(37,37,41,41)(45,45,45,49$, 49) dc rem.

Rows 3-10 (10, 10, 11, 11, 11) (12, 12, 12, 13, 13): Rep Row 2 - 5 dc rem.
Row 11 (11, 11, 12, 12, 12) (13, 13, 13, 14, 14): Ch 3, dc4tog. Fasten off.

## Lower Left Back

With same side facing as Row 1 of Upper Left Back, join yarn with sl st in top ch-3 sp from last row of Upper Back. Work Rows 1-11 (11, 11, 12, 12, 12) (13, $13,13,14,14$ ) as for Upper Left Back.

Right Side, Upper, and Lower Back
Work as for Left side.

## Lower Back Edging

Join MC to side of piece.
Row 1: Ch 1, sc $70(76,82,88,92,98)(104,110,116$,
120,126 ) evenly across piece, turn. Work in Moss
Stitch patt for $2^{\prime \prime}$, ending with a WS row.
Next Row (RS): Loosely sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

## Front

Work as for Back.

Sleeves (make 2)
Beg with CC1 and Stripe Sequence, make $2(2,2,2,2$,
3) $(3,3,3,4,4)$ Square Motifs that are $5(6,6,7,7,5)$
$(5,6,6,5,5)$ rnds each - $19(23,23,27,27,19)(19$,
$23,23,19,19$ ) dc along each side. Sew Square Motifs together to form a strip.

## Upper Sleeve

Note: Continue using MC only throughout remainder of Sleeve.
Join MC to corner of long edge of assembled Motifs.
Row 1: Ch 3, [dc in next $19(23,23,27,27,19)(19,23$,
$23,19,19) \mathrm{dc}$, dc in each of next 2 sps ] across, ending with dc in last ch-3 sp, turn - $42(50,50,58,58,63)$ (63, 75, 75, 84, 84) dc.
Rows 2-9 (8, 8, 7, 7, 9) (9, 8, 8, 9, 9): Rep Row 1. Fasten off.

## Lower Sleeve

Rows 1-8 (7, 7, 6, 6, 8) (8, 7, 7, 8, 8): Work as for Upper Sleeve.

## Sleeve Cuff

Dec row:
XS/S Size Only: Ch 1, [sc2tog, sc in next 3, (sc2tog, sc in next 2) 4 times] 2 times -10 sts dec'd, 32 sts rem. S/M and M Sizes Only: Ch 1, [sc2tog, sc in next 2, (sc2tog, sc in next) 7 times] 2 times -16 sts dec'd, 34 sts rem.
L \& L/1X Sizes Only: Ch 1, [(sc2tog) 4 times, (sc2tog, sc in next) 7 times] 2 times -22 sts dec'd, 36 sts rem. $\mathbf{1 X} / \mathbf{2 X}$ and 2 X Sizes Only: Ch 1, [sc2tog, sc2tog, sc in next] 12 times, sc2tog, sc in last -25 sts dec'd, 38 sts rem.
3X and 3X/4X Sizes Only: Ch 1, [(sc2tog) 6 times,
sc2togl 5 times - 35 sts dec'd, 40 sts rem.
4X/5X and 5X Sizes Only: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 42 times - 42 sts dec'd, 42 sts rem.

## All Sizes:

Work in Moss Stitch patt for 2", ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Loosely sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams using mattress st, leaving 9" unseamed for neck opening. Sew Sleeves to body. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

## Neck

Join MC to one side of Neck opening.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc 56 evenly around making sure you have an even number of sts, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.
Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 2 (counts as sc + ch 1), skip first 2 sts, *sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.
Rnd 3: Ch 2 (counts as sc + ch 1), *sc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk sc; rep from * to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn. Rep Row 3 until Neck measures 2", ending with a WS rnd.
Next rnd (RS): Loosely sl st in each st across. Fasten off.
