



# Sedona Throw

Level: Easy

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

50" X 50"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Multis**  
(100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g,  
180 yds/165 m)

- A - #200-38 Taupe Tone— 3 balls
- B - #200-32 Clay Tone— 2 balls
- C - #200-33 Blue Tone — 2 balls
- D - #200-34 Turquoise Tone— 2 balls
- E - #200-36 Gray Tone — 2 balls
- F - #200-35 Purple Tone — 2 balls
- G - #200-31 Black Tone— 2 balls

**Hook:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

7 Rnds in pattern stitch = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

## PATTERN NOTES

Ch 1 at the beg of rnd does not count as a st. Change colors at the end of each rnd by working slip stitch to join rnd with next color in stripe sequence.

## Throw

*Stripe Sequence: A, B, C, D, E, F, G*

**Rnd 1:** Make magic ring, ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in ring, join yarn in sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc. Drop current color, join new color.

**Rnd 2:** With new color, ch 1, sc in same st as join, [ch 2, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, sc in next dc] 3 times, ch 2, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, join yarn with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc – 4 ch-2 corner sps. Drop current color, join new color.

**Rnd 3:** With new color, ch 1, [(sc, ch 2, sc) in corner sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 4 times, join yarn with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Drop current color, join new color.

**Rnd 4:** With new color, ch 1, [(sc, ch 2, sc) in corner sp, \*ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to next corner, ch 1] 4 times. Drop current color, join new color.

Rep Rnd 4, working in Stripe Sequence until piece measures approximately 50" square.

## FINISHING

### Edging

Join A in any ch-2 corner sp, [(sc, ch 2, sc) in corner, \*ch 3, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to next corner] 4 times, ch 3, join yarn with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.
