

Candy Cane Stocking

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 12"

Length: 18"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- MC: 100-07 Really Red 1 ball
- CC: 100-01 Snow White 1 ball

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needles and US Size 8 (5 mm) dpns *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

18 sts x 20 rnds = 4" in Stranded Pattern. **Save time, check your gauge.**

Skills/Techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches
- Slip stitches
- Stranded colorwork
- Knitting in the round
- Small circumference knitting on dpns
- Ssk, k2tog and p2tog decreases
- M1 increases
- I-Cord

STITCH GUIDE

2-Color Stranded Pattern (multiple of 4 sts) **Rnd 1:** *K2 MC, k2 CC; repeat from *around.

Rnd 2: *K1 CC, k2 MC, k1 CC; rep from *around.

Rnd 3: *K2 CC, k2 MC; rep from *around. Rnd 4: *K1 MC, k2 CC, k1 MC; rep from *around.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

2x2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts)
Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * around.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

I-Cord: * Slide sts to opposite end of dpn. Bring the yarn across the WS to the beginning of the row. Knit 4 sts, place needle in left hand; rep from * until I-Cord is desired length.

PATTERN NOTES

Stocking is knit from the top down in a 2-color stranded pattern with flap heel and round toe. An **I-Cord** loop is added for hanging. Both written and charted instructions are included. Keep floats loose behind work as you change colors.

STOCKING

Cuff

With MC and circular needle, cast on 56 sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work in **2x2 Rib** until cuff measures 2".

Leg

Using both colors, work **2-Color Stranded Pattern** from chart or written directions for

project continued

10". Note which rnd you end on.

Heel

Note: Worked with MC only.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): K14, turn.

Set-up Row 2 (WS): Sl 1 pwise, p27, turn.

Row 3: SI 1 kwise, k27, turn.

Row 4: rep Row 2.

Rows 5-8: rep Rows 3-4 twice.

Heel Turn

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 kwise, k16, ssk, k1, turn. **Row 2 (WS):** Sl 1 pwise, p7, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 3: Sl 1 kwise, k8, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 4: Sl 1 pwise, p9, p2tog, p1, turn. **Row 5:** Sl 1 kwise, k10, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 6: Sl 1 pwise, p11, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 7: Sl 1 kwise, k12, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 8: Sl 1 pwise, p13, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 9: Sl 1 kwise, k14, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 10: Sl 1 pwise, p15, p2tog, p1, turn – 18 sts rem.

Foot

Note: Return to working in the round. With MC and RS facing, knit to marker.

Rnd 1 (pick up rnd): With MC, k9, pick up and knit 4 sts from side of heel flap, m1, (using both colors and resuming stranded color sequence as established on leg) k28, m1, pick up and knit 4 sts, knit to marker – 56 sts on needle.

Continue in **2-Color Stranded Pattern** as established until foot measures 5" from pick up rnd.

Toe

Note: Worked with MC only. Change to dpns when circle gets too small for circular.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: *K5, k2tog; rep from *around.

Rnds 3-5: Knit.

Rnd 6: *K4, k2tog; rep from *around.

Rnds 7-8: Knit.

Rnd 9: *K3, k2tog; rep from *around.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11: *K2, k2tog; rep from *around.

Rnd 12: *K1, k2tog; rep from *around.

Rnd 13: *K2tog; rep from *around – 8 sts rem.

FINISHING

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Using a tapestry needle, thread yarn through rem sts and pull tight to close.

HANGING LOOP

With MC, cast on 4 sts and make an **I-cord** about 6" long and attach securely to inside of cuff. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

cc contrasting color
dpn(s) double point needle(s)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

kwise knitwise

m1 make 1 (1 st inc'd)

MC main color

p purl

p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

pwise
purlwise
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
rnd(s)

sl slip (slip all stitches pwise unless

otherwise noted)

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)WS wrong side
