

**SIZES**

Child (Women, Men)

Shown in Child in 100-69 Deep Teal and Eyelet Insert

Shown in Women in 100-93 Grape Jam and Gull Insert

Shown in Men in 100-08 Pine Green and Cable Insert

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Circumference:** 17 (19½, 22)''

**Height:** 8 (9, 9½)''

**MATERIALS**

**Premier Yarns® Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted** (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- Each Hat – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed needles and 16'' circular needle, US size 5 (3.75mm) 16'' circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker, cable needle, pom pom maker

**GAUGE**

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4'' in St st with larger needles  
**Save time, check your gauge.**

**STITCH GUIDE**

**1/1RC (1/1 Right Cross):** Slip 1 st onto cable needle and hold in back, k1, k1 from cable needle.

**1/1LC (1/1 Left Cross):** Slip 1 st onto cable needle and hold in front, k1, k1 from cable needle.

**Eyelet Insert (7 sts)**

**Setup Rnd:** P2, k1, yo, k1, p2 – 1 st increased, 7 sts total.

**Rnds 1-2:** P2, k3, p2.

**Rnd 3:** P2, slip 1, k2, pass slipped stitch over 2 knit sts, p2 – 6 sts.

**Rnd 4:** P2, k1, yo, k1, p2 – 7 sts.  
Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern.

**Cable Insert (7 sts)**

**Setup Rnd:** P1, k3, m1, k1, p1 – 1 st increased, 7 sts total.

**Rnd 1:** P1, 1/1LC twice, k1, p1.

**Rnds 2 & 4:** P1, k5, p1.

**Rnd 3:** P1, k1, 1/1RC twice, p1.  
Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern.

**Gull Insert (7 sts)**

*Note: On Rnd 1 keep strand from slipping 5 sts loose so fabric will still lay flat.*

**Setup Rnd:** P1, k2, m1, k2, p1 – 1 st increased, 7 sts total.

**Rnd 1:** P1, wyif, slip 5 sts, p1.

**Rnds 2-3:** P1, k5, p1.

**Rnd 4:** P1, k2, insert needle under strand from Rnd 1 and knit next stitch, this will capture the strand in the stitch, k2, p1.  
Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern.

**PATTERN NOTES**

Change to double-pointed needles in Shape Crown section when stitches no longer fit comfortably around circular needle.

**HAT**

With smaller circular needles, cast on 76 (88, 100) sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

# Family Accent Hats

Level: Intermediate

**Rnds 1-9:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* around.

## Begin Accent

Change to larger circular needles. Remove marker, k22 (26, 32), place marker, this is the new beginning of rnd. This moves the join to the back of the hat so the round can begin with the accent insert.

**Rnd 1:** Work setup rnd of accent insert over the next 6 sts, knit to end – 77 (89, 101) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Work accent insert over next 7 sts, knit to end. Continue to work accent insert pattern until hat measures 6½ (7, 7)″.

## Shape Crown

*Note: Keep accent insert stitches in pattern when possible.*

**Rnd 1:** Work accent insert, k6 (8, 10), pm, [k11 (13, 15), k2tog, pm] twice, k12 (14, 16), pm, k11 (13, 15), k2tog, pm, k11 (13, 15), k2tog – 4 sts dec'd.

**Rnd 2:** Work accent insert, knit to end.

**Rnd 3:** \* Work to 2 sts before m, k2tog; rep from \* around – 6 sts dec'd.

Repeat Rnds 2-3, 6 (8, 10) more times – 31 sts remain.

Repeat Rnd 3, 3 more times – 13 sts remain.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches. Pull snug to close top of hat.

## FINISHING

Make pom pom using instructions included in pom pom maker. Attach to top of hat.

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
<b>wyif</b>	with yarn in front
<b>yo</b>	yarn over
