



## Hooded Poncho

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 25¼ (28, 30¾, 33¼)''

**Length:** 28½ (29½, 30, 31)''

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday®**  
Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g,  
180yds/165m)

- 100-61 Rust – 9 (10, 11, 12) balls

**Hook:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

14 sts x 13 rows = 4'' in Alternating Single Crochet patt.

**Save time, check your gauge. Make Pockets first and use as a gauge swatch.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Foundation stitches.
- Working in front and back loops of stitches.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Alternating Single Crochet Pattern** (*even number of sts*)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in front loop of first sc, sc in back loop of next sc, (sc in front loop of next sc, sc in back loop of next sc) across, turn.  
Rep Row 2 for patt.

**Foundation Single Crochet (Fsc)** – ch 2, insert hook into 2nd ch from hook, yo, pull up loop (2 loops on hook), yo, pull through 1 loop (1 ch

made), yo, pull through rem 2 loops on hook (1 foundation single crochet made). \*Insert hook under 2 loops of chain at base of last st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull through 1 loop, yo, pull through 2 rem loops on hook; rep from \* to desired number of fsc.

### PATTERN NOTES

Back is worked from the neck down, pausing at the armholes then rejoining at the neck to create Front Panels. Stitches are picked up at the armholes, allowing you to continue working the remaining Fronts and Back in one piece. Hood and Pockets are worked separately and sewn to Poncho.

### PONCHO

#### Back

**Row 1:** Fsc 88 (98, 108, 116).

Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** until piece measures 14 (15, 16, 17)'' from Row 1, ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

#### First Front

Working on the opposite side of Row 1, join yarn in first st with a sl st.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in next 36 (40, 44, 46) sts, turn – 36 (40, 44, 46) sc.

Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** until piece measures 14 (15, 16, 17)'' from neck, ending on RS row. Fasten off.

#### Second Front

With RS facing, working on opposite side of Row 1, sk center 16 (18, 20, 24) sts from edge of First Front and join yarn in next st with a sl st.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc across, turn – 36 (40, 44, 46) sc.

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Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt**, until piece measures 14 (15, 16, 17)” from neck, end on a WS row.

After working Last Row of Second Front, do not turn or fasten off.

## Establish Body

**Last Row cont'd (WS):** Ch 2 for underarm, cont in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** across Back, ch 2 for next underarm, cont in patt across First Front – 160 (178, 196, 208) sc and 4 underarm chs.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** across, working 1 sc in each underarm ch – 164 (182, 200, 212) sc.

Cont in pattern until Body measures 14½ (14½, 14, 14)” from underarm, end on a WS Row.

After working Last Row of Body, do not turn or fasten off.

## Border

Working up the right front, evenly space sc sts at a rate of 1 sc per row end to neck, sc in each sc of neck opening, evenly space sc sts down left front, and in each sc across bottom edge of back and right front, join to first sc with a sl st. Fasten off.

## Pockets (make 2)

**Row 1: Fsc 22**, turn.

Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** until Pocket measures 8” from Row 1. Fasten off.

## Hood

**Row 1: Fsc 76** (78, 82, 86).

Work in **Alternating Single Crochet patt** until Hood measures 14½ (15, 16, 16¼)” from Row 1. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Fold edge of Hood in half and seam to form the top edge. Mark center of bottom edge of Hood. Pin Hood in place, matching center of Hood with center of Neck opening. Align outer edges along shoulders and Fronts and pin in place. Sew Hood to neck edge. Sew Pockets in place 4” from bottom edge and 2” from side edge of Fronts. Weave in rem ends.
