

Manchester Mittens

SIZE

Adult Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 9"

Height: 9"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- MC: 100-01 Snow White 1 ball
- CC: 100-71 Dove 1 ball

Hook: US Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 1 removable stitch

GAUGE

16 sts and 16 rows = 4" in esc in the round. **Save time, check your gauge.**

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches
- Magic Ring
- Crocheting in the round
- Post stitches
- Extended single crochet
- Sc2tog decreases
- Seaming/sewing

STITCH GUIDE

Extended single crochet (esc): Insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 1 loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over pull through both loops on hook.

Fpdc (front post double crochet): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

PATTERN NOTES

These Mittens are worked from the top down in rounds. The Thumb is worked separately then joined on to the Mitten. Join all rounds with a slip stitch. To join a new color with a slip stitch, insert hook in the first stitch of the round. Pick up the color specified, yarn over with the new color and draw through the stitch and the loop on the hook to complete the slip stitch.

Do not fasten off colors until indicated.

MITTEN

Thumb (make 2)

With MC, make a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Into the **Magic Ring** work 8 **esc**, join to beg **esc**.

Rnd 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), esc in same st, *2 esc in next st, esc in next st; rep from * around, join to beg esc – 12 esc, 4 sts inc'd.

Rounds 3-9: Ch 1, **esc** in each st around, join to beg **esc**.

Fasten off, weave in ends and place stitch marker in last st. Set aside.

Hand

With MC, make a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: Into the Magic Ring work 8 esc, join to beg esc. Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 esc in each st around, join to beg esc – 16 esc, 8 sts inc'd.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, esc in same st, *2 esc in next st, esc in next st; rep from * around, join to beg esc – 24 esc, 8 sts inc'd.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next st, *2 esc in next st, esc in next 2 sts; rep from * around, join to beg esc – 32 esc, 8 sts inc'd.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, **esc** in each st around, change to CC, join to beg **esc**.

Rnd 6: With CC, ch 1, **esc** in each st around, pick up MC, join to beg **esc**.

Rnd 7: With MC, ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next 2 sts, fpdc around next esc 2 rows below, *esc in next 3 sts, fpdc around next esc 2 rows below; rep from * around, pick up CC, join to beg esc – 24 esc, 8 fpdc.
Rnd 8: With CC, ch 1, esc in each st around, pick up MC, join to beg esc.

Rnd 9: With MC, ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next 2 sts, fpdc around next fpdc 2 rows below, *esc in next 3 sts, fpdc around next fpdc 2 rows below; rep from * around, pick up CC, join to beg esc – 24 esc, 8 fpdc.
Rnds 10-19: Rep last 2 rnds, 5 times.

Rnd 20: Rep Rnd 8, fasten off CC and work rem of pattern in MC.

Attach Thumb

Setup Rnd: Ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next 2 sts, fpdc around next fpdc 2 rows below, *esc in next 3 sts, fpdc around next fpdc 2 rows below; rep from * to last 4 sts, esc in next 2 sts, leave last 2 sts unworked to join Thumb, place Thumb next to working loop and starting with marked stitch, make 1 esc into each of the 12 sts around Thumb, continuing on to last 2 unworked sts of Hand, work 1 esc in next st and 1 fpdc around last fpdc 2 rows below, join to beg esc – 44 total sts, 36 esc, 8 fpdc, 12 esc inc'd.

Rnds 2-3: Ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next 2 sts, fpdc around next fpdc, *esc in next 3 sts, fpdc around next fpdc; rep from * to last fpdc before Thumb, fpdc, esc in next 15 esc, fpdc around last fpdc, join to beg esc.
Rnd 4 (dec rnd): Ch 1, esc in same st, esc in next 2 sts, fpdc around next fpdc, *esc in next 3 sts, fpdc around next fpdc; rep from * to last fpdc before Thumb, fpdc, (esc in next esc, sc2tog) 5 times, fpdc around last fpdc, join to beg esc – 39 sts total, 31 esc, 8 fpdc, 5 esc dec'd.

Rnd 5 (dec rnd): Work in est'd patt to last fpdc before Thumb, fpdc, (esc in next esc, sc2tog) 3 times, esc in next esc, fpdc around last fpdc, join to beg esc – 36 sts total, 28 esc, 8 fpdc, 3 esc dec'd.

Rnd 6 (dec rnd): Work in est'd patt to last fpdc before Thumb, fpdc, (esc in next esc, sc2tog) 2 times, esc in next esc, fpdc around last fpdc, join to beg esc – 34 sts total, 26 esc, 8 fpdc, 2 esc dec'd.

Rnd 8 (dec rnd): Work in est'd patt to last fpdc before Thumb, fpdc, sc2tog, esc in next st, sc2tog, fpdc around last fpdc, join to beg esc – 32 sts total, 24 esc, 8 fpdc, 2 esc dec'd.

Cuff

Rnd 1: Ch 1, esc in same st, fpdc around next st, *esc in next st, fpdc around next st; rep from * around, join to beg esc – 32 sts.

Rep Rnd 1 until Mitten meas 9" from top of Hand to bottom of Cuff.

FINISHING

Fasten off, weave in ends. If needed, sew any gaps formed between the Thumb and Hand from attachment.
