



Textured Patches Throw

Level: Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 43"

Length: 50½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 4 oz/113g, 203 yds/186m)

- #100-66 Burgundy – 10 skeins

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) 32" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Diagonal Rib (36 sts)

Row 1 (RS): (K2, p2) 9 times.

Row 2 (WS): (P1, k2, p1) 9 times.

Row 3: (P2, k2) 9 times.

Row 4: (K1, p2, k1) 9 times.

Work Rows 1-4, 12 times (48 rows total) for patt.

Zig Zag (36 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): (K1, p1) 18 times.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: K3, (p1, k9) 3 times, p1, k2.

Row 6: P1, k1, p1, (k1, p7, k1, p1) 3 times, k1, p2.

Row 7: K1, p1, k1, (p1, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1) 3 times, p1, k1, p1.

Row 8: P1, k1, p1, (k1, p1, k1, p3, (k1, p1) twice) 3 times, k1, p1, k1.

Row 9: K1, p1, k1, (k2, (p1, k1) 4 times) 3 times, k2, p1.

Row 10: P3, (p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p3) 3 times, p2, k1.

Row 11: K3, (k4, p1, k1, p1, k3) 3 times, k3.

Row 12: P3, (p4, k1, p5) 3 times, p3.

Row 13: Knit.

Row 14: Purl.

Row 15: (P1, k1) 18 times.

Row 16: Purl.

Work Rows 1-16, 3 times (48 rows total) for patt.

Chevron Rib (36 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K3, p2, (p1, k3, p4, k3, p3) twice, k3.

Row 2 (WS): P3, (k2, p3, k1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p3) twice, k2, p3.

Row 3: K3, p2, (k2, p1, k2, p2) 4 times, k3.

Row 4: P3, (k2, p1, k1, p3, k2, p3, k1, p1) twice, k2, p3.

Work Rows 1-4, 12 times (48 rows total) for patt.

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Arrows (36 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): (K3, p3) 6 times.

Row 3: (P1, k3, p2) 6 times.

Row 4: (K1, p3, k2) 6 times.

Row 5: (P3, k3) 6 times.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8: (P3, k3) 6 times.

Row 9: (P2, k3, p1) 6 times.

Row 10: (K2, p3, k1) 6 times.

Row 11: (K3, p3) 6 times.

Row 12: Purl.

Work Rows 1-12, 4 times (48 rows total) for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This throw is worked in one piece from one end to the other with the edging picked up and knit.

Throw

Cast on 192 sts. Work in **Garter St** for 1", end having just worked a WS row.

Section One

Row 1 (RS): K2, *work **Diagonal Rib** over 36 sts, p2, work **Zig Zag** over 36 sts, p2; rep from * to last 38 sts, work **Diagonal Rib** over 36 sts, k2.

Row 2 (WS): K2, *work **Diagonal Rib** over 36 sts, k2, work **Zig Zag** over 36 sts, k2; rep from * to last 38 sts, work **Diagonal Rib** over 36 sts, k2.

Rep these 2 rows 23 more times for a total of 48 rows.

Work 2 rows in **Rev St st**.

Section Two

Row 1 (RS): K2, *work **Chevron Rib** over 36 sts, p2, work **Arrows** over 36 sts, p2; rep from * to last 38 sts, work **Chevron Rib** over 36 sts, k2.

Row 2 (WS): K2, *work **Chevron Rib** over 36 sts, k2, work **Arrows** over 36 sts, k2; rep from * to last 38 sts, work **Chevron Rib** over 36 sts, k2.

Rep these 2 rows 23 more times for a total of 48 rows. Work 2 rows in **Rev St st**.

Rep **Section One and Two** once more (200 rows total not including **Garter St**). Work **Section One**, but do not work the 2 rows of **Rev St st**, instead work 1" in **Garter St**. Bind off all sts.

Edging

With circular needle and RS facing, pick up evenly and knit 230 sts along the long side of the throw. Work in **Garter St** for 1". Bind off all sts loosely. Repeat on other side.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations


Garter st	Knit every row.
k	knit
meas	measures
p	purl
patt	pattern
rep	repeat(ing)
Rev St st	Reverse Stockinette stitch: Purl on RS rows, knit on WS rows.
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
WS	wrong side

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

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Zig Zag




Diagonal Rib




Key

Arrows




Chevron Rib



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
