

Woodland Winter Ornaments

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 6"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Everyday Worsted®* (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 4oz/113g, 203yds/186m)

- #100-14 Caramel (A) 1 ball
- #100-01 Snow White (B) 1 ball
- #100-64 Bark (C) 1 ball
- #100-66 Burgundy (D) 1 ball
- #100-65 Spruce (E) 1 ball
- #100-61 Rust (F) 1 ball
- #100-12 Black (G) 1 ball
- #100-67 Admiral Blue (H) 1 ball
- #100-23 Mist (I) 1 ball

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker, 3 sets of 7mm safety eyes, poly-fill for stuffing, small pom pom maker or fork to make tiny pom pom

GAUGE

20 sc x 20 rows = 4" in Single Crochet Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The pieces are worked in a spiral. Do not join at the end of rounds. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first st of the round, and move the marker up with each subsequent round.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

REINDEER

Head

With A, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnds 5-8: Sc in each sc around – 24 sc. Attach safety eyes (using photo as a guide). Stuff Head and continue working as follows:

Rnd 9: *1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 10: *1 sc in next sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc. Fasten off. Finish stuffing Head and set aside.

Body

With A, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *1 sc in next sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *1 in next 2 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: *1 sc in next 3 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep

from * around - 30 sc.

Rnds 6-9: Sc in each sc around – 30 sc.

Rnd 10: *1 sc in next 3 sc; sc2tog; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnds 11-12: Sc in each sc around – 24 sc.

Rnd 13: *1 sc in next 2 sc; sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnds 14-15: Sc in each sc around – 18 sc.

Rnd 16: *1 sc in next sc; sc2tog – 12 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off. Stuff Body and set aside.

Tummy Fur

Make with B.

Row 1: Ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook across. Ch 1, turn – 3 sc.

Rows 2-3: 2 sc in next sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn -7 sc.

Rows 4-5: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn – 7 sc.

Row 6: Sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog. Ch 1, turn – 5 sc.

Row 7: Sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog. Ch 1, turn – 3 sc.

Row 8: Sc3tog – 1 sc.

Sc around entire edge, fasten off.

With tapestry needle, and using photo as a guide, sew Tummy Fur to Body.

Legs (Make 2)

With C, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around. Drop C. Join A through the last loop -9 sc.

Rnds 3-9: Sc in each sc around – 9 sc. Fasten off. Stuff Legs and set aside.

Arms (Make 2)

With C, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around. Drop C. Join A through the last loop – 6 sc.

Rnds 3-7: Sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Rnd 8: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from *

around – 9 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in each sc around – 9 sc. Fasten off. Stuff Arms and set aside.

Antlers (Make 2)

Piece 1:

With C, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring – 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Rnds 3-6: Sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Fasten off. Lightly stuff Piece 1 and set aside.

Piece 2:

With C, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 4 sc in ring – 4 sc.

Rnds 2-4: Sc in each sc around – 4 sc.

Fasten off. Lightly stuff Piece 2 and using the photo as a guide, sew Piece 1 to Piece 2.

Sew Antlers to Head between Rnds 2 and 5.

Tail

Piece 1:

With B, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring – 3 sc.

Rnds 2-3: 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Fasten off.

Piece 2:

With A, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from *

around - 9 sc.

Fasten off. With tapestry needle, sew Piece 2 to the

top of Piece 1.

Sew tail to back at approx. Rnd 5 of Body.





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Muzzle

With B, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off. Stuff Lightly and using photo as a guide,

sew to Head between Rnds 6 and 10.

Nose

With D, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Fasten off. Sew to Muzzle.

Ears (Make 2)

With A, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring – 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc - 6 sc.

Rnd 3: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc -9 sc.

Rnd 4: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc – 12 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew. Pressing the ear flat, push the two bottom corners together and using a tapestry needle sew them together. Sew each Ear to Head between Rnds 3 and 6.

Scarf

With E, ch 36.

Row 1: Sc in ch next to hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn – 35 sc.

Rows 2-3: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn – 35 sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 18 strands of yarn approx. 3" long.

Holding 3 strands of yarn together, fold strands in hald and use crochet hook to pull through the short edge of the scarf, pass ends through the folded loop, and pull ends to tighten. Space 3 groups of fringe evenly along each end of the scarf. Trim Fringe.

FINISHING FOR REINDEER

Note: Use photo as a guide for placement throughout. Sew Head to Body.

Sew Arms and Legs to Body.

Wrap scarf and sew to Tummy Fur and neck to secure to body.

Weave in any remaining ends.

FOX

Head

Work same as for Reindeer with F for Rnds 1-8 and B for Rnds 9-11.

Body

Work same as for Reindeer with F for Rnds 1-16 and B for Rnd 17.

Tummy Fur

Work same as for Reindeer.

Legs

Work same as for Reindeer with G for Rnds 1-6 and F for Rnds 7-9.

Arms

Work same as for Reindeer with G for Rnds 1-6 and F for Rnds 7-9.

Tail

With B, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring – 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Rnd 3: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around. Drop B. Join F through last loop – 9 sc.

Rnds 5-11: Sc in each sc around.

Stuff Tail and continue working as follows:

Rnd 12: *1 sc in next sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 6 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off. Sew Tail to back at approx. Rnd 5 of Body.

Muzzle

With G, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring. Drop G. Join F through the last loop − 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

For Rnd 3, you will use 2 colors at the same time.

Rnd 3: Continuing with F - 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc. Drop F and with B, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc -9 sc.

Rnd 4: Pick up F and sc in next 6 sc. Drop F and with B, sc in last 3 sc.

Fasten off. Stuff Lightly and using photo as a guide, sew to Head between Rnds 6 and 10.

Ears

Work same as for Reindeer with G for Rnd 1 and F for Rnds 2-5.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off. Do not sew the bottom corners together as you did with the Reindeer.

Set aside.

Hat

With H, ch 9.

Row 1: Working in the blo, sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn – 8 sc.

Rows 2-20: Working in the blo, sc in each sc across – 8 sc.

Fold piece and hold beginning chain edge and last row together, sl st across to join fabric into a tube.

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread tail around top edge and pull snug to gather and close top of hat. Set aside.

Hat Brim

With H, ch 4.

Row 1: Working in the blo, sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn – 3 sc.

Rows 2-20: Working in the blo, sc in each sc across -3 sc.

Fasten off, set aside.

FINISHING FOR FOX

Note: Use photo as a guide for placement throughout. Using your preferred method and B, make a tiny pompom and secure to top of hat.

Sew Hat to Head.

Sew Hat Brim around the top edge of Hat.

Sew Ears behind Hat Brim on top of Hat.

Sew Head to Body.

Sew Arms and Legs to Body.

Weave in any remaining ends.

RACCOON

Note: Make the Eye Fur pieces first, as they will need to be secured to the Head before securing the safety eyes.

Eve Fur (Make 2)

With G, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Fasten off.

Attach B in any sc.

Ch 1, sc in next 5 sc. Fasten off.

Head

With I, work same as for Reindeer.

After finishing Rnd 8, sew the Eye Fur pieces to the face using the photo as a guide. Secure safety eyes and continue working the rest of the Head.

Body

With I, work same as for Reindeer.

Legs

Work same as for Reindeer with G for Rnds 1-4 and I for Rnds 5-9.

Arms

Work same as for Reindeer with G for Rnds 1-3 and I for Rnds 4-9.

Tail

Work same as for Fox with G for Rnds 1-2, 5-6, 9-10, and 13; and I for Rnds 3-4, 7-8, and 11-12.

Muzzle

With G, Make Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 3 sc in ring. Drop G, Join B through the last loop – 3 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sc.

Rnd 3: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each sc around – 9 sc.

Fasten off. Stuff Lightly and using photo as a guide, sew to Head between Rnds 6 and 10, overlapping over the Eye Fur pieces already sewn on.

Ears

Work same as for Reindeer with B for Rnd 1 and I for Rnds 2-5.

Rnd 6: Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Fasten off. Do not sew the bottom corners together as you did with the Reindeer.

Sew to Head between Rnds 2 and 7.

Using G and a tapestry needle, embroider the inner ear.



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Cowl

With D, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 6

Rows 2-20: Sc in each sc across – 6 sc.

Wrap around neck and sew, sewing short edge of cowl together on back of neck.

FINISHING FOR RACCOON

Note: Use photo as a guide for placement throughout.

Sew Head to Body.

Sew Arms and Legs to Body.

Weave in any remaining ends.

FINISHING

Cut 3 strands of B approx. 6" long.
Using crochet hook, loop yarn through the back off
the head of each ornament and tie in a knot or bow.

Abbreviations

blo back loop only

ch chain

dec'd decrease(d)
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
sc single crochet

sc2tog single crochet the next 2 sts together

(1 st dec'd)

sc3tog single crochet the next 2 sts together

(2 sts dec'd)

sl st slip stitch
