

Family Waffle Scarves

SIZES

Child (Women, Men)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 6 (7%, 8)" Length: 52 (66, 70)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted* (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

• Each Scarf – 2 (3, 3) balls
Shown in Child in 100-30 Glass
Shown in Women in 100-28 Mustard and
100-31 Peacock
Shown in Men in 100-61 Rust and
100-66 Burgundy

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

13 dc x 8 rows = 4" in pattern Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, double crochet and front post double crochet stitches.
- Adding fringe.

STITCH GUIDE

Fpdc (front post double crochet): Yo, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

SCARF

Ch 20 (26, 29).

Row 1 (WS): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (skipped 2 chs do not count as a st), and each ch across, turn – 18 (24, 27) dc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (does not count as a st here and throughout), dc in 1st dc, *fpdc around next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc; rep from * to last 2 dc, fpdc around next dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 3 (WS): Ch 2, dc in next 2 dc, *fpdc around each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc; rep from * to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 until scarf measures 52 (66, 70)", ending with Row 2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 44 (60, 68), 14" lengths of yarn. Holding 2 strands together, add fringe in 11 (15, 17) evenly across each end of the scarf. Trim even.

Abbreviations

ch chain
 dc double crochet
 rep repeat(ing)
 RS right side
 st(s) stitch(es)
 WS wrong side

yo yarn over
