TYPE Knit

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 22" from top of head to
bottom of body

Width: 12³/₄" not including feet

MATERIALS

[Premier® Yarns Fable®](#)
([90% Acrylic, 10% Polyester;](#)
[7oz/200g, 131yds/120m](#)).

- 2142-02 Mermaid – 3 balls

NEEDLES & NOTIONS

- [US Size 11 \(8mm\) straight and set of dpns or 16" circulars \(for body\) or size needed to obtain gauge](#)
- [Tapestry needle](#), stuffing, a small amount of smooth black yarn for sewing details

GAUGE

- 11 sts x 17 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Head, Ears, and Arm/Foot pieces are knit flat using straight needles and then seamed. Body is knit in the round using circular needles. Head is stuffed and all pieces are sewn to body. Finally, embroidered facial features add even more personality!

HEAD

Cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: Kfb in each st – 12 sts inc'd, 24 sts.

Row 5: [K1, kfb] 12 times – 12 sts inc'd, 36 sts.

Rows 6-8: Work even in St st.

Row 9: K17, kfb in each of next 2 sts, k17 – 2 sts inc'd, 38 sts.

Row 11: K18, kfb in each of next 2 sts, k18 – 2 sts, inc'd, 40 sts.

Row 13: K19, kfb in each of next 2 sts, k19 – 2 sts inc'd, 42 sts.

Row 15: K20, kfb in each of next 2 sts, k20 – 2 sts inc'd, 44 sts.

Row 17: K20, [k2tog] twice, k20 – 2 sts dec'd, 42 sts rem.

Row 19: K19, [k2tog] twice, k19 – 2 sts dec'd, 40 sts rem.

Row 21: K18, [k2tog] twice, k18 – 2 sts dec'd, 38 sts rem.

Row 23: K17, [k2tog] twice, k17 – 2 sts dec'd, 36 sts rem.

Row 25: [K4, k2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 30 sts rem.

Row 27: [K3, k2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 24 sts rem.

Row 29: [K2, k2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 18 sts rem.

Row 31: [K2tog] 9 times – 9 sts dec'd, 9 sts rem. Cut yarn, leaving a 24" tail.

Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through rem sts, remove needle and pull end tightly, closing top; do not cut yarn. Sew back seam with same yarn and mattress st, stuffing firmly.

ARM/FOOT (MAKE 4)

Cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb in each st – 6 sts inc'd, 12 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: [K1, kfb in next st] 6 times – 6 sts inc'd, 18 sts.

Rows 4-12: Work even in St st.

Row 13: [K1, k2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Row 14: Purl.

Row 15: [K2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 6 rem.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through rem sts, remove knitting needle and pull end tightly, closing top; use yarn tail and mattress st to seam each piece.

EAR (MAKE 2)

Cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb in each st – 6 sts inc'd, 12 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: [K1, kfb in next st] 6 times – 6 sts inc'd, 18 sts.

Rows 4-32: Work even in St st.

Row 33: [K1, k2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Row 34: Purl.

Row 35: [K2tog] 6 times – 6 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through rem sts, remove knitting needle and pull end tightly, closing top; use yarn tail and mattress st to seam each piece.

BODY

Using MC and circular needle, leaving a 24" tail, cast on 70 sts. Place marker (pm) and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Knit – 70 sts.

Rep Rnd 1 until Body meas 16". Bind off all sts.

Fasten off leaving a 24" tail. Using mattress st, seam across the top and bottom openings.

FINISHING

Using photos as a guide, sew Ears to Head, Head and Arms/Feet to Body. Embroider features with small amount of black or dark colored worsted weight yarn (like Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted 100-12 Black) for eyes and leftover MC for nose. Weave in all ends.
