# PREMIER®



Favorite Knit Hat

Level: Intermediate

# **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Head Circumference: 17½" without stretching

## **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Marl (100% antipilling acrylic; 100gm/180 yds)

#103-04 Red Marl – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and set of 4 double pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker,

pompom maker

#### **GAUGE**

22 sts x 24 rows = 4" in K2, p2 ribbing without stretching

Save time, check your gauge.

#### STITCH GUIDE

K2, P2 Ribbing – multiple of 4 sts

**Rnd 1:** K1, p2, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last st, k1. Rep Rnd 1 for pattern.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

The ribbing used for this hat is very elastic. The hat will comfortably fit heads measuring 18" to 22".

#### HAT

Using circular needle, cast on 96 sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work in K2, p2 ribbing until piece measures 8".

# **Shape Crown**

Note: Change to double-pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably around the circular needle.

**Rnd 1:** \* K1, p2, k2, p1, k2tog; rep from \* to end - 84 sts.

**Rnd 2:** \* K1, p2, k2, p1, k1; rep from \* to end. **Rnd 3:** \* K1, p2, k2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 72 sts.

**Rnd 4:** \* K1, p2, k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** \* K1, p2, k1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 60 sts.

**Rnd 6:** \* K1, p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \* K1, p2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 48

**Rnd 8:** \* K1, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \* K1, p1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 36 sts.

**Rnd 10:** \* K1, p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** \* K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 24 sts.

**Rnd 12:** Knit.

**Rnd 13:** K2tog 12 times – 12 sts.

Rnd 14: K2tog 6 times - 6 sts.

Break yarn. Use tapestry needle to draw tail through remaining 6 sts. Pull tight and fasten off.

# **Finishing**

Weave in ends.

Make pompom and sew to top of Hat.

knit

knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd) k2tog

purl р

repeat(ing) rep rnd(s) round(s)

stitch(es) st(s)
