



# Fingerless Gloves

Level: Intermediate

## SIZES

Women's Medium

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Hand Circumference:** 5½"

**Arm length:** 8¾"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Serenity® Sock** (50% Wool, 25% Rayon from Bamboo, 25% Nylon; 50gm/230 yds)

- #155-05 Borealis - 2 balls

**Needles:** US Size 2 (2.75mm) set of 4 double pointed knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Stitch markers, stitch holder, tapestry needle

## GAUGE

40 sts x 48 rows = 4" in K5, P1 Rib without stretching

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**K2, P1 Rib** – Multiple of 3 sts

**Rnd 1:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for pattern.

**K5, P1 Rib** – Multiple of 6 sts

**Rnd 1:** \* K5, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for pattern.

## PATTERN NOTE

The rib pattern used for these gloves has a lot of elasticity. These gloves will comfortably fit a hand circumference (measured around the palm above the thumb) of 5½" to 8".

## GLOVES

### Cuff

Cast on 72 sts. Divide sts over 3 needles. Pm for beginning of rnd and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work 8 rnds in K2, P1 Rib.

### Arm

**Rnds 1-10:** \* K5, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** K2tog, k3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k3, ssk, p1 - 70 sts.

**Rnds 12-20:** K4, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k4, p1.

**Rnd 21:** K2tog, k2, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k2, ssk, p1 - 68 sts.

**Rnds 22-30:** K3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k3, p1.

**Rnd 31:** K2tog, k1, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k1, ssk, p1 - 66 sts.

**Rnds 32-40:** K2, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

**Rnd 41:** K2tog, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, ssk, p1 - 64 sts.

**Rnds 42-50:** K1, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k1, p1.

**Rnd 51:** P2tog, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2tog - 62 sts.

**Rnds 52-60:** P1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Rnd 61:** K2tog, k4, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k4, ssk, p1 - 60 sts.

**Rnds 62-70:** \* K5, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 71:** K2tog, k3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k3, ssk, p1 - 58 sts.

**Rnds 72-80:** K4, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k4, p1.

**Rnd 81:** K2tog, k2, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k2, ssk, p1 - 56 sts.

**Rnds 82-90:** K3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k3, p1.

## Thumb gusset

**Rnd 1:** M1, pm, k3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k3, pm, m1, p1 – 58 sts.

**Rnd 2:** K4, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k4, p1.

**Rnd 3 – Increase Rnd:** Knit to marker, m1, sl marker, k3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to 3 sts before marker, k3, sl marker, m1, knit to last st, p1 – 2 sts increased.

Continuing in established pattern, rep Increase Rnd every other rnd 3 more times, then every 3rd rnd 4 times – 19 sts in gusset between markers; 74 sts total.

## Hand

**Rnd 1:** Knit to marker, sl marker, k3, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to 3 sts before marker, k3, remove marker, place 19 gusset sts on holder removing beginning of rnd marker, cast on 1 st to bridge gap, pm for new beginning of rnd – 56 sts.

**Rnd 2:** K2tog, k1, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k1, ssk, k1 – 54 sts.

**Rnd 3:** K2, p1, \* k5, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3. Rep Rnd 3, 15 more times, or until hand is  $\frac{3}{8}$ " less than desired finished length.

**Next Rnd:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last rnd 3 more times.

Loosely bind off in established rib.

## Thumb

Move thumb sts from holder to needles – 19 sts.

Join yarn at cast-on edge of hand.

**Rnd 1:** Pick up and knit 2 sts along cast-on edge of hand, then [p1, k2] 6 times, p1, pm for new beginning of rnd – 21 sts.

**Rnd 2:** \* K2, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 2, 4 more times.

Loosely bind off in established rib.

## Finishing

Weave in ends.

Block gently.

## Abbreviations

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together
<b>m1</b>	make 1
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>p2tog</b>	purl 2 stitches together
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>ssk</b>	slip, slip, knit
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
