Boxed Beads Blanket





TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Premier® Yarns Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 36½" Length: 47"

GAUGE:

10 sts x 8 rows = 4" in patt Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Flora™ (85% Acrylic, 14% Rayon from Bamboo, 1% Nylon; 3.5oz/100g, 98yds/90m)

2159-05 Blush – 16 balls

HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- US Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Single, extended single and double crochet stitches.
- Cluster stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Slanting Cluster (SICI): [Yo, insert hook around stem of previous dc from right to left, yo, pull loop through] 3 times in same place, yo, pull through first 6 loops on hook, yo pull through both loops on hook.

Boxed Beads (multiple of 3 sts + 1; multiple of 3 chs + 1 for foundation chain) **Row 1 (WS):** Sc in 3rd ch from hook (skipped chs count as esc), sc in next ch, *esc in next ch, sc in each of next 2 chs; rep from * to last ch, esc in last ch, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as esc), *dc in next sc, **SICI** in next st, skip next sc, esc in esc; rep from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as esc), *sc in **SICI**, sc in dc, esc in esc; rep from * across, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat, back and forth in rows. A double crochet border is added directly to the blanket after the Main Body is complete.

BLANKET

MAIN BODY

Ch 92. Work Row 1 of **Boxed Beads** patt, then rep Rows 2-3, 45 times, then rep Row 2, 1 more time.

Next row: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Do not fasten off.


BORDER

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each st to end of row, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in corner, dc evenly along side of blanket, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in corner, dc in each ch from beg-ch row, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc in corner, dc evenly along other side of blanket, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in corner, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnds 2-6: Dc in each dc around, working [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in corners.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.
