



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Dishcloth: 7" square

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Premier Home™ Cotton** (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 80 gm/140 yds)

- #38-20 Sunflower (A) – 1 skein
- #38-01 White (E) – 1 skein
- #38-15 Sage (F) – 1 skein

**Premier® Yarns Premier Home™ Cotton** (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 60 gm/105 yds)

- #44-25 Tangerine Splash (B) – 1 skein
- #44-24 Flamingo Splash (C) – 1 skein
- #44-23 Violet Splash (D) – 1 skein

**Hook:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

12 dcs x 7 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Stitch Guide

**Adjustable Ring:** Leaving a 6-8" tail, hold tail end of yarn in left hand. Make a ring by wrapping yarn around fingers, placing working yarn behind tail. Hold ring just made at the juncture of the two yarns. Insert hook in center of ring, yo, pull up lp. Pull tail of yarn to close ring after Rnd 1 is complete.

## DISHCLOTH

With A, begin with adjustable circle.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as dc), dc 11 in circle, join with sl st in beg ch-2 - 12 dcs.

**Rnd 2 (worked in front loop only):** With B, ch 2, [dc 2, ch 2, sl st] in flo of same st, \* [sl st, ch 2, dc 2, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st; rep from \* to end - 12 petals.

**Rnd 3 (worked in back loop only):** With B, sl st in back loop of first st of Rnd 1, ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in blo of same st, dc 2 in blo of each st to end, join with sl st in beg ch-2 - 24 dcs.

**Rnd 4 (worked in front loop only):** With C, ch 2, dc in flo of same st, [dc, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st, \* [sl st, ch 2, dc] in flo of next st, [dc, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st; rep from \* to end - 12 petals.

**Rnd 5 (worked in back loop only):** With C, sl st in back loop of first st of Rnd 3, ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in blo of same st, dc in blo of next st, \* dc 2 in blo of next st, dc in blo of next st; rep from \* to end, join with sl st in beg ch-2 - 36 dcs.

**Rnd 6 (worked in front loop only):** With D, ch 2, dc in flo of same st, tr 2 in flo of next st, [dc, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st, \* [sl st, ch 2, dc] in flo of next st, tr 2 in flo of next st, [dc, ch2, sl st] in flo of next st; rep from \* to end – 12 petals.

**Rnd 7 (worked in back loop only):** With D, sl st in back loop of first st of Rnd 5, ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in blo of same st, dc in blo of next 2 sts, \* dc 2 in blo of next st, dc in blo of next 2 sts; rep from \* to end, join with sl st in beg ch-2 – 48 dcs.

**Rnd 8 (worked in front loop only):** With E, ch 2, dc in flo of same st, tr 2 in flo of next 2 sts, [dc, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st, \* [sl st, ch 2, dc] in flo of next st, tr 2 in flo of next 2 sts, [dc, ch 2, sl st] in flo of next st; rep from \* to end – 12 petals. Fasten off E.

**Rnd 9 (worked in back loop only):** Join F in blo of any st of Rnd 7, ch 2, \*working in blo [dc 2, ch 2, dc 2] in next st (corner made), dc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next st; rep from \* 3 more times, join with a sl st to beg ch-2 – 60 sts, 4 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 10 (worked in both loops):** Ch 2, dc in next 2 sts, \*[dc 2, ch 2, dc 2] in next ch-2 sp (corner made), dc in next 4 sts, ch 1, dc3tog over next 3 sts, ch 1, dc in next st, ch 1, dc3tog over next 3 sts, ch 1, dc in next 4 sts; rep from \* 3 more times, omitting last 3 dc's, join with a sl st to beg ch-2.

*Note: count ch-1 sps as sts.*

**Rnd 11 (worked in both loops):** Ch 2, \*dc in next 4 sts, [dc 2, ch 2, dc 2] in next ch-2 sp (corner made), dc in next 4 sts, ch 1, dc3tog over next 3 sts, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc3tog over next 3 sts, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc3tog over next 3 sts, ch 1; rep from \* 3 more times, ending last rep with a dc2tog and omitting last ch 1, join to beg ch-2.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>dc3tog</b>	dc 3 sts together
<b>flo</b>	front loop only
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sk</b>	skip
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tr</b>	treble crochet
