## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Serenity ${ }^{\circledR}$ Garden (100\% Dralon Microfiber; 65g/185 yd)

- DN800-08 Sea-2 $2(2,3,4)$ balls

Needle: US Size 3 ( 3.25 mm ), US Size 4 ( 3.5 mm ), US Size 5 ( 3.75 mm ), US Size 6 ( 4 mm ) needles or size needed to get gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, 1-1/2" button, stitch markers, US Size C-2 $(2.75 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook

## GAUGE

24 sts $\times 28$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Garter St on smallest needles

## STITCH GUIDE

Chevron Stitch (multiple of 14 sts +2 )
Row 1 (RS): K1, * kf\&b, k4, ssk, k2tog, k4, kf\&b; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 2: Purl.
Rep Rows 1-2 for Chevron Patt St.

Chevron Garter Stitch (multiple of 14 sts +2 )
Row 1 (RS): K1, * kf\&b, k4, ssk, k2tog, k4, kf\&b; rep from * to last st, k1.

## Row 2: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2 for Chevron Garter Patt St.

## DRESS <br> Yoke

With smallest needles cast on 192 (216, 234, 270) sts.

Row 1 (WS): S1 wyif, k23 (26, 28, 31), place marker (pm), k48 (54, 59, 72), pm, k48 (54, 58, $62)$, pm, k48 (54, 59, 72), pm, k24 (27, 29, 32). Row 2: S1 wyif, *k to 2 sts before $m, k 2$ tog, $s m$, ssk; rep from * 3 more times, knit to end of row - 8 sts dec'd.

Row 3: S1 wyif, knit to end of row.
Rep Rows 2-3, 8 (10, 10, 14) more times - 120 $(128,146,150)$ sts rem.
Bind off all sts.

## Skirt

With the Size 4 needles, cast on 1 st, pick up 24 $(27,29,32)$ sts along the cast-on edge of the Yoke, cast on $8(9,12,14)$ sts, leaving the next $48(54,59,72)$ sts of the Yoke free for the right armhole, pick up $48(54,58,62)$ sts along the center section of the cast-on edge of the Yoke, cast on $8(9,12,14)$ sts, leaving the next $48(54$, 58,62 ) sts of the Yoke free for the left armhole, pick up $24(27,29,32)$ sts along the last section of the caston edge of the Yoke, cast on 1 st 114 (128, 142, 156) sts.
Row 1 (WS): P1, knit to last st, p1.
Row 2: Work Row 1 of Chevron Stitch patt.
Continue to work in patt until Skirt meas 2 (2, $3,3)^{\prime \prime}$.
Switch to Size 5 needles. Continue to work in Chevron St as established until Skirt meas 6 ( $6 ½, 8,8$ )".
Switch to Size 6 needles. Continue to work in Chevron St as established until skirt meas 10 (1112, 13, 14)".

## Garden Party Dress

Bottom Edging
Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Chevron Garter St.
Rows 2-10: Continue in Chevron Garter St.
Bind off all sts loosely.

## HEADBAND

## Band

With Size 4 needles, cast on 5 sts.
Row 1: S1 wyif, knit to end of row.
Rep Row 1 until Band measures 13 (15, 15, 17)". Bind off all sts.

## Leaf

With Size 4 needles, cast on 3 sts.
Row 1 and all odd rows: Knit
Row 2: K1, yo, k1, yo, k1-5 sts.
Row 4: K2, yo, k1, yo, k2-7 sts.
Row 6: K3, yo, k1, yo, k3-9 sts.
Row 8: Knit.
Row 10: Ssk, k5, k2tog - 7 sts rem.
Row 12: Ssk, k3, k2tog - 5 sts rem.
Row 14: Ssk, k1, k2tog - 3 sts rem.
Row 16: S1, k2tog, psso-1 st rem.
Thread yarn through last st and pull tight.

## Flower

Ch 5, sl st to join into ring.
Rnd 1: [SI st, ch 5, \{dtr\} 3 times, ch 5, sl st to finish petal] into each ch st -5 petals created. Fasten off.

## PURSE

With Size 3 needles, cast on 72 sts.
Rows 1-9: Knit. Switch to Size 4 needles.
Row 10 (RS): K1, * k5, k2tog, yo; rep from * 9 more times, k1.
Row 11: Purl.
Row 12: Work Row 1 of Chevron St.
Continue to work in Chevron St until Purse meas 5" from cast-on edge.

## Bottom

Row 1 (RS): K1, *k5, ssk, k2tog, k5; rep from * 4 more times, k1-62 sts.
Row 2 and all even rows: Purl.
Row 3: K1, *k4, ssk, k2tog, k4; rep from * 4 more times, k1-52 sts.
Row 5: K1, *k3, ssk, k2tog, k3; rep from * 4 more times, k1-42 sts.
Row 7: K1, *k2, ssk, k2tog, k2; rep from * 4 more times, k1-32 sts.
Row 9: k1, *k1, ssk, k2tog, k1; rep from * 4 more times, k1-22 sts.
Row 11: k1, *ssk, k2tog; rep from * 4 more times, k1 - 12 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 1 yd long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Use tail to sew side seam of Purse.

## Drawstring

Make a 20" long crochet chain.

## FINISHING

## Dress

Seam the back of the skirt, leave the back of the Yoke open. With the tail from the bind-off on the Yoke, chain 6 sts and sew down end to create a button loop. Sew button on opposite side to match. Weave in all remaining ends. Block.

## Headband

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge of Band. Sew Leaf and Flower over seam on Band. Weave in all remaining ends. Block.

## Purse

Thread drawstring through yarn-overs on Row 10.
Knot ends of drawstring together. Weave in all remaining ends.
