#### Finished Measurements

**Length:** 54"

**Width:** 15½"

#### Materials

**Nazli Gelin Garden 3** (100% Egyptian Giza Mercerized Cotton; 50g/136 yds)

- 300-12 Deep Blue – 6 balls

**Needles:** US Size 6 (4 mm) 24" circular ndls OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

**Notions:** US Size C-2 (2.75 mm) crochet hook, tapestry needle

#### Gauge

24 sts x 28 rows = 4" in patt st

SAVE TIME, CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### Navona Pattern Stitch

Multiple of 22 sts

**Row 1 (RS):** P1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, [p1, k1] 3 times, yo, k1, yo, [k1, p1] 3 times, k2tog, k1.

**Row 2:** P2, [k1, p1] 3 times, p3, [p1, k1] 3 times, p2, k1, p1, k1. **Row 3:** P1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k1, [p1, k1] 2 times, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, [k1, p1] twice, k1, k2tog, k1. **Row 4:** P3, [k1, p1] twice, p5, [p1, k1] twice, p3, k1, p1, k1. **Row 5:** P1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, [p1, k1] 2 times, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, [k1, p1] twice, k2tog, k1. **Row 6:** P2, [k1, p1] twice, p7, [p1, k1] twice, p2, k1, p1, k1. **Row 7:** P1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k1, yo, ssk, yo, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k1.

**Row 8:** [P1, k1] twice, p11, [k1, p1] 3 times, k1.

**Row 9:** P1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k1, [yo, ssk] twice, yo, k1, p1, k2tog, k1.

**Row 10:** P2, k1, p13, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1. **Row 11:** P1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k1, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k3, [yo, ssk] twice, yo, k1, p2tog, k1. **Row 12:** P1, k1, p15, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1. **Row 13:** P1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, [yo, k2tog] twice, yo, k5, [yo, ssk] twice, yo, k2tog, k1. **Row 14:** P19, k1, p1, k1.



Rep rows 1-14 for patt.

#### SHAWL

Cast on 352 sts. **Row 1 (RS):** Work row 1 of patt st across. Work even in patt as set until piece measures 15½", ending after row 14 of patt. Bind off all sts loosely.

#### FINISHING

With crochet work, join yarn in last st. Work 1 rnd sc around sides, cast-on, and bound off edges. Join to first st with a sl st and fasten off. Weave in ends and block.
