

## Gradient Wrapped Letters

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: approx. 16" when stacked

## **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *D.I.Y. Gradient Yarn* (100% antipilling acrylic; 200gm/394 yds)

• 1 set

Notions: set of four 8" tall chipboard block letters, ruler, marker, tacky glue

## **LETTERS**

Place the 4 letters in 2 rows in the order you wish to stack them.

Using the pencil and the ruler to measure and draw straight lines, divide the letters horizontally into 5 equal sections.

Yarn will wrap horizontally around the letters to fill each of the 5 sections, with the lightest color at the top and the darkest color at the bottom. Use photo as a guide.

Before wrapping the horizontal sections, prepare any surfaces of the letters that won't be covered by the horizontal wraps, such as the top and bottom of the horizontal bars on the H and the E shown. The bottom of each letter should be left unwrapped to help letters stand. Using the corresponding color for the section, cut approx. 10 pieces slightly longer than the area to be covered. Place a small amount of glue on the area and smooth it flat. Place the pieces of yarn neatly side by side to fill the area. Repeat until all similar areas are covered.

Begin wrapping the letters. Place glue along all edges of each section as you go, including along the pencil lines that divide the color segments. Neatly wrap yarn on each section, taking care to keep wraps horizontal.
