Linen Stitch Tablet Case

SIZES

S (L)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width: 7½ (9½)"

Length: $10\frac{1}{2} (11\frac{1}{2})^{"}$

MATERIALS

Premier[®] **Yarns** *Hipster*[™] *Cotton* (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 229yds/210m)

 C1: 2010-06 Rainbow Rollerskates – 1 ball

• C2: 2010-10 Hello Hydrangea – 1 ball

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, 1-1½" button

GAUGE

18 sts x 16 rows = 4" in Linen Stitch Pattern Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Seaming.

STITCH GUIDE

Linen Stitch (odd number of sts, worked flat) Row 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st) across to last st, sc in last st, turn. Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp) across to last ch-1 sp, sc in last ch-1 sp, sc in last sc, turn. Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next sc, (sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next sc) across to last st, sc in last st, turn. Pap Pows 2.2 for pattern

Rep Rows 2-3 for pattern.

PATTERN NOTES

This Tablet Case is worked flat, in one piece from bottom to top, creating a rectangle. The rectangle is folded in half and seamed at the bottom edge and at one side edge. The button is sewn on separately.

TABLET CASE

Base

With C1, ch 68 (86). **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 67 (85). **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. **Row 3:** Work Row 1 of Linen Stitch Pattern, drop C1, join C2.

Body

Rows 1-2: With C2, Work Rows 2-3 of Linen Stitch Pattern, drop C2, pick up C1. Rows 3-4: With C1, work Rows 2-3 of Linen Stitch Pattern, drop C1, pick up C2. Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures 10 (11)" from foundation chain, end having just worked a Row 2 or 4.

Button Loop

Row 1: Pick up or continue with C1, sc in each sc and each ch-1 sp across, turn. Row 2: Ch 1, sc in next 17 (21) sts, ch 13, sc in each rem sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, working 1 sc in each ch of Button Loop.

FINISHING

Fasten off, weave in ends. Fold rectangle in half and whipstitch lower edges and side edges together, leaving upper section open for tablet. Test placement of button opposite Button

project continued

Loop, approximately 1-1½" from top edge of piece. With placement correct, sew button in place. Weave in rem ends.
