



### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 10½"

**Height:** 18"

### MATERIALS

**Premier Yarns® Home™ Cotton** (85% cotton, 15% polyester; 80 gm/140 yds)

- #38-01 White (A) – 1 skein
- #38-07 Cranberry (B) – 1 skein
- #38-14 Christmas Green (C) – 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) double point needles  
*or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 2 stitch markers (of different colors)

### GAUGE

14 sts x 24 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### WINE BAG

With A, cast on 15, pm, cast on 15 sts, pm in second color to mark beg of rnd. Join to work in the rnd being careful not to twist. Divide sts evenly on 3 dpns.

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 for 4".

**Eyelet Rnd:** \*K2tog, yo; rep from \* around.

**Stripe Sequence:** \*Work 7 rnds B, 7 rnds C; rep from \* 3 more times .

Following Stripe Sequence throughout, shape Wine Bag top as follows:

**Rnd 1:** [Sm, knit to one st before marker, kfb, k1] twice - 2 sts increased.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds, 5 more times - 42 sts.

Work even in Stockinette st (knit every rnd) through completion of Stripe Sequence.

### Bag Bottom

Change to A. Cut B and C.

**Rnd 1:** [Sm, k2tog, knit to 2 sts before next marker, ssk] twice - 4 sts decreased.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Rep these 2 rnds, 8 more times - 6 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving a 12" tail.

Using tapestry needle, thread yarn through rem sts. Pull to draw closed and secure.

## FINISHING

### Drawstring

Cut 24" lengths of yarn in each color. Holding the three strands together, tie a knot at end and braid strands to form drawstring. Tie a second knot to secure. Thread cord through Eyelet Rnd at base of cuff. Insert bottle, fold cuff and tie drawstring.

### Abbreviations

<b>beg</b>	begin(ning)
<b>dpn</b>	double point needle
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>kfb</b>	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sm</b>	slip marker
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
