

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS****Length:** 15" (not including fringe)**Width:** 11"**MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Home® Cotton
 (85% Recycled Cotton, 15% Polyester;
 1.94oz/55g, 96yds/88m)

- 44-57 Cream Stripe - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) straight needles *or*
size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, locking stitch marker,
 12" wood dowel or decorative stick

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.**STITCH GUIDE****Chevron Pattern**

Set Up Row (RS): K24, place locking m on next
 st, k24.

Row 1 (WS): K2, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2 (RS): K2, kfb, knit to 1 st bef marked st,

CDD, knit to last 3 sts, kfb, k2.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

CDD (Centered Double Decrease): Sl 2 sts
 together, k1, p2sso — 2 sts dec'd.

PATTERN NOTES

This Wall Hanging is worked from one end to the other with increases at each edge and two decreases at the center to create the Chevron shape. Fringe is added once the knitting is complete, then it is attached to the dowel. Move the marker up every few rows to easily keep track of the center stitch.

WALL HANGING

Cast on 49 sts, work even in **Chevron Pattern** until piece meas 15" from cast-on edge, bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Wash and block to finished measurements, if desired.

Fringe

Cut 24 - 12" lengths of yarn, attach in groups of 2 approx. 1" apart on the single point end of the Wall Hanging, trim even.

Attach the double pointed end of the Wall Hanging to the dowel by threading the yarn with tapestry needle through each point and then around the dowel. Repeat a few times to secure. Cut 2 pieces of yarn to desired length, with yarn held together tie each end to dowel for hanging.

Weave in ends.
