



Chevron Stripe Kitchen Towel

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 14" not including hanging loop

Width: 10"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Home® Cotton

(85% Recycled Cotton, 15% Polyester;
1.94oz/55g, 96yds/88m)

- Color A: 44-55 Turquoise Stripe or 44-61 Spring Stripe – 1 ball

Premier® Yarns Home® Cotton

(85% Recycled Cotton, 15% Polyester;
2.65oz/75g, 131yds/120m)

- Color B: 38-01 White – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 1-1" button

GAUGE

20 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Chevron Stitch (*Multiple of 13 sts + 1*)

Row 1 (RS): With A, * kfb, k4, ssk, k2tog, k3, kfb; rep to last st, k1.

Row 2: With A, knit.

Rep Rows 1-2, 3 more times

Row 9: With B, * kfb, k4, ssk, k2tog, k3, kfb; rep to last st, k1.

Row 10: With B, purl.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

TOWEL

With A, cast on 53 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Work in **Chevron Stitch** until Towel meas 13" ending with Row 2.

Cut A.

Next Row: With B, *k5, ssk, pm, k2tog, k4; rep to last st, k1 – 45 sts. Knit 1 row.

Dec Row: * K to 2 bef m, ssk, sm, ktog; rep 3 more times, k to end – 8 sts dec'd.

Knit 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows, 4 more times.

Next Row: *Ssk, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, ssk, k2tog – 8 sts rem.

Hanging Loop

With B, knit 36 rows.

Button Hole

Row 1: K2, bind off 4 sts, k2.

Row 2: K2, cast on 4 sts, k2.

Knit 4 rows. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew button at beginning of hanging loop.

Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations

dec('d) decrease(d)

k knit

kfb knit into the front and back of the next st
(1 st inc'd)

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

patt pattern

rem remain(ing)

rep repeat(ing)

RS right side

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them
back to left needle in this position, knit them
together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch: Knit on RS rows,
purl on WS rows.
