

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 40" (including wooden ring)

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Premier Home® Cotton XL (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 10.5 oz/300 g, 82 yds/75 m)

• 1097-05 Burgundy – 1 ball **Notions:** 2'' wooden ring, white glue, 5 - 1'' and 10 – ¼" diameter wooden barrel beads, 9" flowerpot

STITCH GUIDE

Square-Knot (uses 4 strands)

- 1. Take the left strand and pass it under the center strands, and over the right strand.
- 2. Take the right strand and pass it over the center strands, and through the loop on the left from top to bottom. Pull both ends to tighten knot around center strands.
- **3.** Take the right strand and pass it under the center strands, and over the left strand.
- **4.** Take the left strand and pass it over the center strands, and through the loop on the right from top to bottom. Pull both ends to tighten knot around center strands - one Square Knot formed.

Repeat Steps 1-4 for **Square-Knot**.

Spiral-Knot (uses 4 strands) Work as for **Square-Knot**, but only using steps 1-2.

PLANT HANGER

Cut 6 – 6yd lengths, and 2 – 1yd lengths of Premier Home® Cotton XL.

Fold the 6 long cords in half over the wooden ring. Using one of the short cords, hold the long cords together and wrap them tightly with the short cord, starting just under the ring, wrapping for approximately 1½". Pass both ends of the short cord through the

wraps and trim flush. Secure ends with white glue to prevent raveling.

Bands

Separate the 12 cords into 3 groups of 4. Tie each group of 4 into 10" of **Square-Knots**. Reverse the "active" and "filler" strands. Slide a 1" barrel bead onto the 2 new filler strands.

Tie **Spiral-Knots** for 5".

Slide a ¼" barrel bead onto the filler strands (do not reverse strands here).

Tie **Square-Knots** for 3".

Cradle

When all 3 Bands are complete, rearrange the strands, combining 1 active and 1 filler strand from each Band with 1 active and 1 filler strand from its neighbor.

Leaving 4" untied, tie 2½" (or about half the width of the bottom of your flowerpot) of **Square-Knots** in each of the new groups.

With the 2^{nd} 1 yd length of cord, wrap tightly around all 12 ends for 1". Pass both ends of the short cord through the wraps and trim flush. Secure ends with white glue to prevent raveling.

Thread a bead onto each cord. Tie a knot in each cord approximately 6" below wrap.

Trim each end flush just below knot and secure end with white glue.
