
PREMIER®



FINISHED MEASUREMENT

5" diameter

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Home Cotton* (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 1.94oz/55g, 96yds/88m)

• #34-21 Sahara Splash – 1 ball **Needle:** US Size 8 (5mm) knitting needle *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** tapestry needle, scissors

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Garter st Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The pot scrubber is worked in short row wedges to form a circle. Two circles are sandwiched together and sewn together to form the pot scrubber.

STITCH GUIDE Short Row Circle Pattern Row 1 (RS): K 8, turn. Rows 2 and all even numbered rows: K across. Row 3 (RS): K7, turn. Row 5 (RS): K6, turn. Row 7 (RS): K6, turn. Row 9 (RS): K4, turn. Row 11 (RS): K across. Row 12 (WS): K across. Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

SCRUBBER

Cast on 9 sts. K 1 row. Work Short Row Circle patt eight times total, binding off on last 12th row. Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Sew the cast on and bind off edges tog to form a circle.

Make another identical piece. Thread the tapestry needle with the tail and seam the outside edges tog to form a double thick circle. Tack the centers tog securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)

WS	wrong side
