

Couch Remote Caddy

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 16" Length: 25"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** Home® Cotton (85% Recycled Cotton, 15% Polyester; 2.65oz/75g, 131yds/120m)

• 44-20 Grey Splash – 4 balls

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to

obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch

markers

#### **GAUGE**

12 hdc x 9 rows = 4''Save time, check your gauge.

#### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Working in third loop of half double crochet.
- Seaming.

#### STITCH GUIDE

Third Loop Half Double Crochet (3rd lp of hdc): Work into the 'third lp' of the half double crochet stitch. The horizontal line at the back of the st is the third lp. Working into this lp creates a unique, ribbing effect.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Caddy is made in one panel. The end of the panel will fold up and be sewn into place, divided in sections and sewn to create pockets.

#### **COUCH REMOTE CADDY**

Ch 51.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk and in

each ch across, turn - 50 hdc.

Rows 2-61: Ch 1, hdc in each st across, turn. Place a st marker on at the beg and end of Row

Row 62: Ch 2, working in the 3<sup>rd</sup> lp of hdc, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 63: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 64-83: Rep Rows 62-63.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

With RS facing out, fold panel making marked Row 61 the bottom row at fold, Rows 61-83 will form front of pocket and the ribbing from 3<sup>rd</sup> lp hdc will be on outside. Join yarn at end of fold in marked st (Row 61),

ch 1, working through front and back layers, sc evenly along side edge, joining the pocket sides; at top edge, working in front panel only, 3 sc in first st of row, working through front and back layers, sc in each st aross to last st, 3 sc in last st, sc evenly along side of next edge. Fasten off.

#### **Individual Pockets**

Use st markers to determine and mark where individual pockets will be. Thread tapestry needle with a long length of yarn and sew vertically through both front and back panels to create pockets.

Weave in ends.
