

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

10" x 10"

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Home Cotton** (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 2.65oz/75g, 131yds/120m)

- #38-20 Sunflower – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

**GAUGE**

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**DISHCLOTH**

Cast on 44 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

**Next Row:** K4, pm, purl to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

**Begin Pattern**

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, sl m, \*yo, k2, pass yo over last 2 sts; rep from \* to m, sl m, k4.

**Row 2:** K4, sl m, p to m, k4.

**Row 3:** K4, sl m, k1, \*yo, k2, pass yo over last 2 sts; rep from \* to last st before m, k5.

**Row 4:** K4, sl m, p to m, k4.

Continue to rep Rows 1-4, until dishcloth measures 9 1/2", ending with a RS row.

Knit 5 rows.

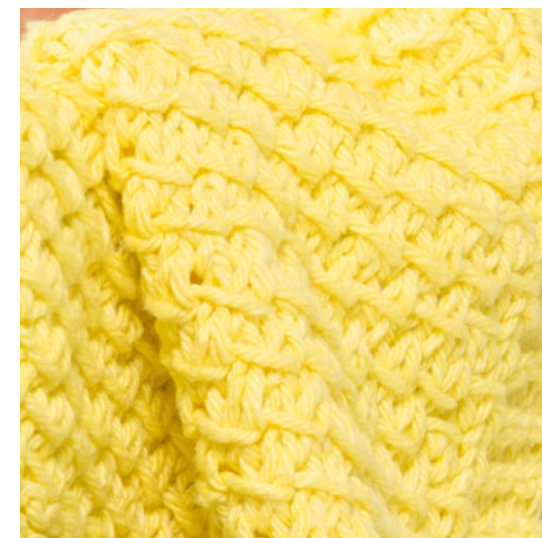
Bind off all sts.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

**Abbreviations**

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette Stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
