

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Diameter: 4.5"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Home Cotton (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 1.94oz/55g, 96yds/88m)

• #44-37 Raindrop Splash – 1 ball (1 ball can make up to 6-7 coasters)

Premier® Yarns *Home® Cotton* (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 2.8oz/80g, 128yds/128m)

• #38-26 Pewter – 1 ball (1 ball can make up to 8-9 coasters)

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts x 6 rows = 4" in Dc Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

COASTER (make 1 in each color or a whole set) Start with a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (this counts as a dc here and throughout), dc 14 times in the ring, pull yarn tail to close circle. SI st to top of beginning ch-4.

Rnd 2: Ch 4, dc once in same st, 2 dc in next dc and each dc around.

Rnd 3: Ch 4, sk next dc, *dc3tog, ch 2*; rep from * to last st of rnd, making sure to begin each dc3tog in the same st in which you just completed the previous dc3tog. Hdc in last st, sl st to the top of beginning ch-4.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first ch-2 sp, *3 sc in next ch-2 sp*; rep from * to end of rnd, sl st in beginning ch-1.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch chain

dc double crochet

dc3tog double crochet the next 3 sts together (2 st dec)

dec decrease

hdc half double crochet

rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
sc single crochet

sk skip sl st slip stitch sp space st(s) stitch(es)

tog together
