



## Sport Coasters

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 4"

**Length:** 4"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Home® Cotton**  
(85% Recycled Cotton, 15% Polyester;  
2.65oz/75g, 131yds/120m)

#### Football:

- A: 38-01 White - 1 ball
- B: 38-23 Burgundy - 1 ball

#### Basketball:

- A: 38-01 White - 1 ball
- B: 38-06 Orange - 1 ball
- C: 38-26 Pewter - 1 ball

#### Baseball:

- A: 38-11 Cornflower - 1 ball
- B: 38-01 White - 1 ball
- C: 38-07 Cranberry - 1 ball

#### Golf:

- A: 38-11 Cornflower - 1 ball
- B: 38-15 Sage - 1 ball
- C: 38-01 White - 1 ball
- D: 38-07 Cranberry - 1 ball
- E: 38-16 Black - 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

16 sc x 16 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Reading a color chart.
- Surface slip stitch.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Surface slip stitch (surface sl st):** With yarn in back, insert hk in a sp between 2 sts within a row, pull up a slip knot, \*insert hk in next sp between 2 sts within a row, yo, pull up a lp through the fabric to front, yo, pull through lp on hk; rep from \* until surface sl st section is complete.

### PATTERN NOTES

Make Coaster for each graph. See each individual pattern for Trim and Finishing Details. To change yarn color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Work over the strand of the old color as you work each row. When working from chart, read odd-numbered rows from right to left and even-numbered rows from left to right.

### COASTER

With A, ch 16.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk and in each ch across, turn – 15 sc.

Beg with Row 2 of chart, work in single crochet and change yarn color following chart, until all 15 rows of chart have been completed. Do not fasten off.

### FOOTBALL

#### Trim

**Rnd 1:** Join with B, ch 1, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced along side edge; working along opposite side of foundation ch, work 3 sc in ch at base of first sc of Row 1, sc in each ch across to ch at base of last sc, 3 sc in last ch, work 15 sc evenly spaced along next side edge,

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work 3 sc in first sc of Row 15, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc – 70 sc.

## Finishing Details

Thread needle with A and stitch on center seam.  
Weave in ends.

## BASKETBALL

### Trim

**Rnd 1:** Join with C, ch 1, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced along side edge; working along opposite side of foundation ch, work 3 sc in ch at base of first sc of Row 1, sc in each ch across to ch at base of last sc, 3 sc in last ch, work 15 sc evenly spaced along next side edge, work 3 sc in first sc of Row 15, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc – 70 sc.

## Finishing Details

Use C to **surface sl st** basketball seams. Weave in ends.

## BASEBALL

### Trim

**Rnd 1:** Join with C, ch 1, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced along side edge; working along opposite side of foundation ch, work 3 sc in ch at base of first sc of Row 1, sc in each ch across to ch at base of last sc, 3 sc in last ch, work 15 sc evenly spaced along next side edge, work 3 sc in first sc of Row 15, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc – 70 sc.

## Finishing Details

Use C to **surface sl st** baseball seams. Weave in ends.

## GOLF

### Trim

**Rnd 1:** Continue with A, do not turn, work 15 sc evenly spaced along side edge; working along opposite side of foundation ch, work 3 sc in ch at base of first sc of Row 1, sc in each ch across to ch at base of last sc, 3 sc in last ch, work 15 sc evenly spaced along next side edge, work 3 sc in first sc of Row 15, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc – 70 sc.

## Finishing Details

Beg at Row 14, join D and **surface sl st** down to Row 3, creating the flagpole.  
Weave in ends.

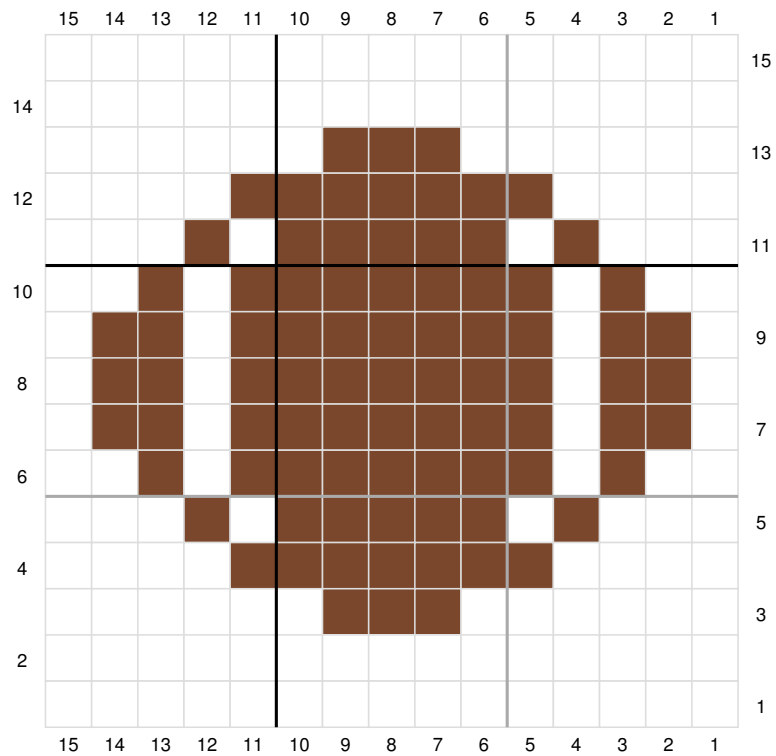


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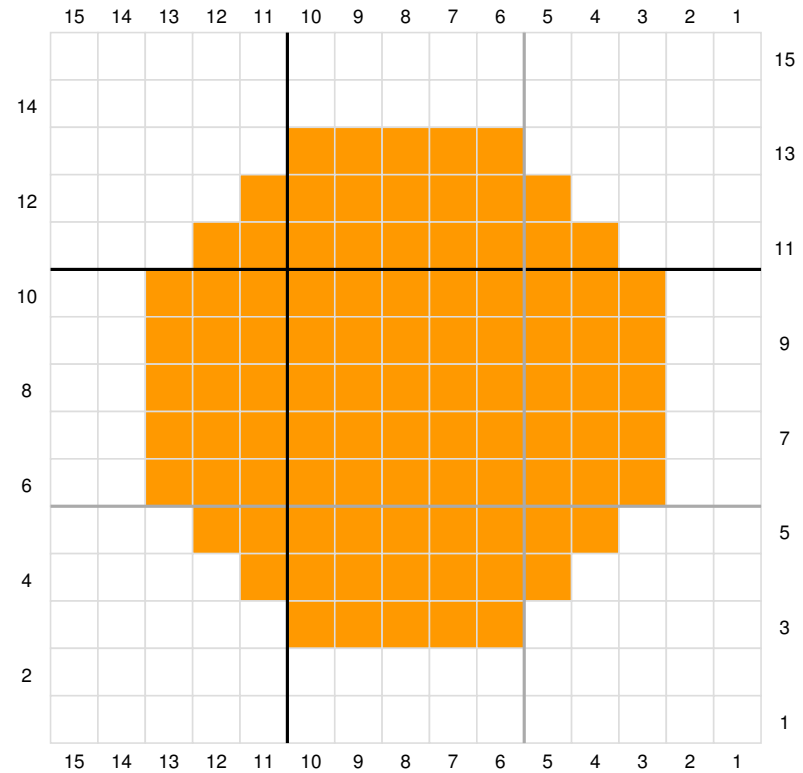

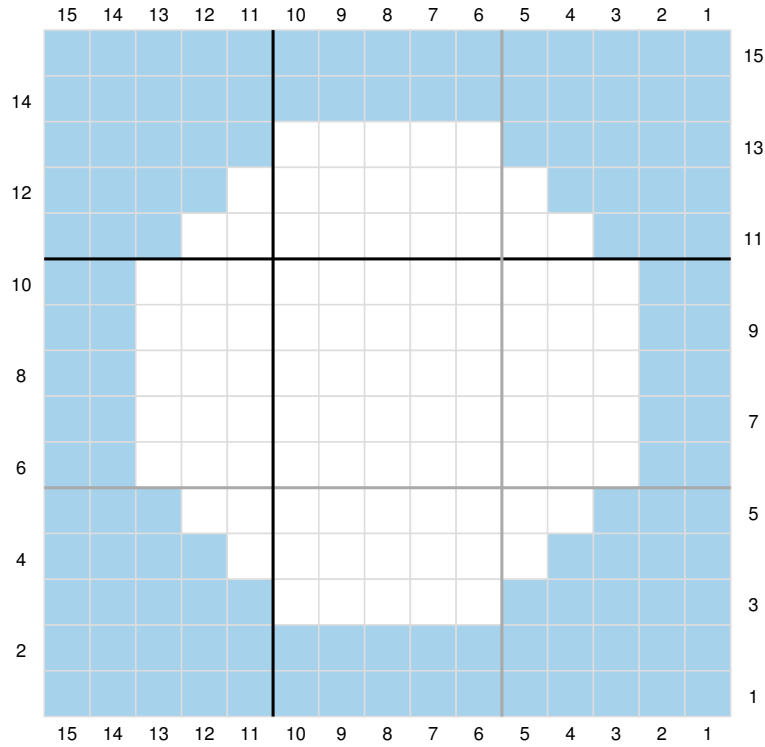
