



Whirling Pan Protector &amp; Handle Cover Set

**SIZES**

Pan Protector Sizes: Small (Medium, Large)

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Pan Protector Diameter: 6 (8, 10)"

Handle Cover: 4" long x 2 ¾" circumference.

**MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns Home Cotton** (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 1.94oz/55g, 96yds/88m)

- #44-26 Honeydew Splash – 3 balls for the set

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5mm) and I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, removable stitch marker, scissors, tape measure

**GAUGE**

14 Sc x 16 rows = 4" on US I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook

15 Sc, 16 rows = 4" on US Size 7 (4.5mm) crochet hook

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**PATTERN NOTES**

The pan protectors are worked from the inside out in a spiral.

The larger hk size is used for the Pan Protector. The smaller hk size is used for the pan handle cover.

**STITCH GUIDE**

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

**PAN PROTECTOR**

With larger hk, Ch 4. Join with a sl st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2, (yo, draw up a lp through the ring, yo, draw through 2 lps on hk) twice, yo and draw through all lps on hk (cluster made), \*ch 2, (yo draw up a lp through the ring, yo, draw through 2 lps on hk) three times, yo, and draw through all lps on hk. Rep from \* 4 times more, join with a sl st in top of first cluster. 6 clusters. Pm to mark beg of rnd. You will be working in a spiral where rnds are not joined (except on last rnd).

**Rnd 2:** \*Ch 4, 1 sc in top of next cluster, rep from \* around, join with a sl st in top of first cluster- 6 ch-4 spaces.

**Rnd 3:** \*Ch 4, 2 sc in next ch-4 space, 1 sc in next sc; rep from \* 5 times more.

**Rnd 4:** \*Ch 4, 2 sc in next ch-4 space, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc's, sk 1 sc, rep from \* 5 times more.

**Rnd 5:** \*Ch 4, 2 sc in next ch-4 space, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc's, sk 1 sc; rep from \* 5 times more.

**Rnd 6:** \*Ch 4, 2 sc in next ch-4 space, \*\*1 sc in each of the next 4 sc's\*\*, sk 1 sc; rep from \* 5 times more.

Continue to work in this manner, having one more sc worked between the \*\* on each rnd until piece meas 6 (8, 10)" across. Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## HANDLE COVER

With smaller hk, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 5 sc's in ring, sl st in first sc to join, tighten ring. 5 sc

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch now and throughout), 2 sc in each st around, sl st into first sc. 10 sc

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, sl st in first sc.  
Rep Rnd 3 until piece measures 4" from beg. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
