

# Huggable Henley

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



#### **SIZES**

Child's 2 (4, 6, 8)

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Chest: 24 (26, 28, 30)" Length: 12 (13, 14, 16)"

## **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** Fable™ (80% polyester; 20% antipilling acrylic; 85 gm/250 yds)

- #1030-35 Peter and the Wolf (A) 1 (1, 2, 2)
   ball(s)
- #1030-03 Hansel and Gretel (B) 1 (1, 1, 2)
   ball(s)

**Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, 2-7/8"

buttons

## **GAUGE**

16 sc x 17 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

#### **BACK**

With A, ch 49 (53, 57, 61).

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 48 (52, 56, 60) sc.

Work even in sc until piece measures 8 (8½, 9, 10)", ending with a WS row.

# **Shape Armholes**

**Row 1 (RS):** SI st in first 7 sts, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in each sc across, leaving last 6 sc unworked, turn – 36 (40, 44, 48) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

Rep Row 2 for 7 (8, 9, 11) more rows or until armholes measure 4 (4½, 5, 6)". Fasten off.

#### FRONT

Work as for Back to Row 2 of armhole shaping.

#### **Left Front**

**Shape Neck and Shoulders** 

Next Row (RS): Ch 3, dc in next 17 (19, 21, 23) dc, turn – 18 (20, 22, 24) dc.

Rep last row 5 (6, 7, 9) more times.

Next Row (RS): Ch 3, dc in 10 (11, 12, 13) dc for shoulder, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc in each dc to end, turn. Fasten off.

# **Right Front**

# **Button Placket**

Ch 7.

**Next Row (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as dc) and in next 3 ch, join to center front with dc in first dc, dc in each dc to end, turn -23 (25, 27, 29) dc.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc in each dc to end, turn.

Rep last row 5 (6, 7, 9) more times.

# **Shape Neck and Shoulders**

Next Row (RS): SI st in first 13 (14, 15, 16) dc, dc in each dc to end, turn – 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc in each dc to end. Fasten off.

# **SLEEVES** (make 2)

With B, ch 25 (25, 25, 29).

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 24 (24, 24, 28) sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Rep Row 2 for 2".

Row 3 (Increase Row): Ch 1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn – 2 sts increased.

Rows 4-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Rep last 4 rows 3 (5, 7, 9) more times – 32 (36, 40, 48) sc.

Next Row: Ch 1, sc in each sc to end, turn.

Rep last row until piece measures 9 (11, 12, 13)". Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams. Match top center point of sleeve to shoulder seam. Sew sleeves into armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew bottom of Button Placket overlapping left front neck edge. With A, work 1 row of sc evenly spaced around edges of neckline and placket. Sew buttons in place on left front. Button placket using spaces between double crochet sts as buttonholes. Weave in ends.
