



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 55”

**Width:** 46”

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Just® Chenille Cone* (100% Polyester; 35oz/1000g, 1312yds/1200m)

- 2104-16 Hot Pink – 1 cone

**Needle:** US Size 11 (8 mm) 32” or longer circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

10½ sts x 14 rows = 4” in pattern stitch

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Slipping stitches with yarn in front or back.
- Working **usl** stitch.

## STITCH GUIDE

**Slip Stitch Honeycomb** (*multiple of 6 sts + 13*)

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, p1, \*sl3 wyif, p3; rep from \* to last 8 sts, sl3 wyif, p1, k4.

**Row 2 (WS):** K5, \*sl3 wyib, k3; rep from \* to last 8 sts, sl3 wyib, k5.

**Row 3:** Knit.

**Rows 4, 6, 10, and 12:** K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

**Row 5:** K6, \*k1 usl, k5; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k1 usl, k6.

**Row 7:** K4, p4, \*sl3 wyif, p3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p1, k4.

**Row 8:** K8, \*sl3 wyib, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5.

**Row 9:** Knit.

**Row 11:** K9, \*k1 usl, k5; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

**Usl (Under Slipped Stitches):** Take the right-hand needle under the threads of the slipped stitches, then pick up the next stitch on the left-hand needle and knit this stitch and the threads together.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is worked flat from end to end with slipped stitches to create a honeycomb effect.

## BLANKET

Cast on 121 sts.

Work 1½” even in Garter st.

Work even in **Slip Stitch Honeycomb** patt, until piece measures 53½” from cast-on edge.

Work 1½” even in Garter st. Loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>Garter st</b>	knit every row
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>wyib</b>	with yarn in back
<b>wyif</b>	with yarn in front
