



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 41¼"

**Length:** 42"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Just Yarn® Worsted Value**  
(100% Acrylic; 14oz/400g, 875yds/800m)

- A: 2125-01 White – 1 ball
- B: 2125-02 Light Gray – 1 ball

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 32" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

16 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Broken Garter Pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Binding off in pattern.

## STITCH GUIDE

**Broken Garter Pattern** (*multiple of 6 sts + 3*)

**Row 1:** \*K3, p3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

This pattern is worked flat on a circular needle to accommodate the large number of stitches. To avoid an excess of ends to weave in during finishing, do not cut yarn when switching to next color. Carry the yarn along the side by dropping the color not in use and bringing up new color behind the strand of the color just worked.

## THROW

With A, cast on 165 sts.

Work in **Broken Garter Pattern** throughout, working stripes as follows:

Work 2 rows with A; work 2 rows with B, until piece measures 42" from cast-on edge, end having just worked 2 rows in B.

Loosely bind off in patt.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
