



One Skein Garter Set

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat: 20" circumference x 12" tall (with brim unfolded)

Mitts: 7" circumference x 9½" long

Cowl: 43" circumference x 9½" tall

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Just Yarn® Worsted Value (100% Acrylic; 14oz/400g, 875yds/800m)

- 2125-22 Magenta – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm) straight *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, pom-pom maker

GAUGE

16 sts x 32 rows = 4" in garter stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Casting on and binding off.
- Knit stitch/garter stitch.
- Making a pom-pom.
- Seaming.

PATTERN NOTES

Each piece is knit flat in garter stitch and then seamed together.

GARTER SET

Hat

Cast on 48 sts. Work even in Garter st until piece measures 20". Bind off all sts.

Cowl

Cast on 38 sts. Work even in Garter st until piece measures 43". Bind off all sts.

Mitts (make 2)

Cast on 38 sts. Work even in garter st until

piece measures 7". Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge on Cowl.

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge on Hat.

Make a running stitch along one open end of hat. Gather and pull taut to close for top of Hat. Make a pom-pom following manufacturer's directions and sew to top of hat.

Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge on Mitts for 2½", leave 2½" unsewn for thumb opening, and sew remaining 4½" together for lower edge. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

Garter st	Knit every row
st(s)	stitch(es)
