Tasseled Poncho

#### SIZE

One Size

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Neck Opening: 22" Length: 33"

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Just Yarn® Worsted Value (100% Acrylic; 14oz/400g, 875yds/800m)

• MC: 2125-13 Seaglass – 1 ball

CC: 2125-18 Aran – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) straight or size

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, crochet hook for

adding tassels

#### **GAUGE**

16 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Garter st **Save time, check your gauge.** 

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit stitch.
- Seaming.
- Making and attaching tassels.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Poncho is worked flat as two panels which are then sewn together. Tassels are made and added last as a fun detail.

#### **PONCHO**

Panel (make 2)

With MC, cast on 80 sts. Work even in Garter st until piece measures 30", loosely bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Refer to Diagram on next page and seam Panels together.

#### Tassels (make 66)

Cut 6-4" lengths of CC. Holding lengths together as one, fold in half. Use crochet hook to add Tassels approximately every  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " along bottom edges by inserting hook through the fabric, pulling loop of Tassel through to the other side and then pulling ends through the loop. Trim ends to approximately 1".

Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**

CC contrasting color
Garter st Knit every row.
MC main color
st(s) stitch(es)
