

Knit Ponytail Hat

Level: Intermediate



SIZES

Adult Medium (Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Head Circumference: 20½ (21½)''

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Puzzle (100% Acrylic; 200gm/328 yds)

- #1050-02 Jigsaw – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge.*

Notions: Stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 22 rows = 4'' in Stockinette Stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

SPECIAL STITCHES

C6L – Cable 6 Left: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k3, k3 from cable needle.

C6R – Cable 6 Right: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back, k 3, k3 from cable needle.

w&t – wrap and turn: Slip next st with yarn to WS of work, move yarn between needles to RS of work, slip st back to left hand needle, turn work. You are now in position to continue with the next row. You have wrapped the yarn around the base of an un-worked st to prevent the formation of holes where short rows end.

HAT

Cast on 45 (48) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P12, k1, pm, p12 (15), pm, p5, pm, w&t.

Row 2 (RS): K5, k12 (15), p1, k12.

Row 3: P12, k1, purl to center marker, w&t.

Row 4: Knit to next marker, p1, C6R, C6L.

Row 5: P12, k1, purl to last marker purling wrap together with wrapped st when you come to it, knit wrap together with next st, knit to end.

Row 6: Knit to third marker, p1, k12.

Row 7: P12, k1, p17 (20), w&t.

Rep Rows 2-7, 17 (18) more times, then work Rows 2-6 once more.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew bound off edge to cast on edge. Weave in ends. Block lightly.

Abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together

p purl

pm place marker

rep repeat

rnd(s) round(s)

st(s) stitch(es)
