

Pattern Collection: Accessories



Lace Scarf

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 6½" Length: 60"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura *Cotton True Sport* (100% Pima Cotton; 50g/197 yds

• 110 Stormy Blue – 2 balls

Needles: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) straight or size

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2 stitch markers

GAUGE

24 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Lace Pattern **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

Tbl: Through the back loop.

Twisted Ribbing

(odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, p1, * k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to last st,

k1.

Row 2: P1, k1 tbl, * p1, k1 tbl; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt

Lace Pattern

(multiple of 10 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): K1 * k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1;

rep from * to end. Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Row 3: K1, * yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k2; rep from

* to end.

Row 4: Purl.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

SCARF

Cast on 43 sts. Work in Twisted Ribbing patt for 6 rows.

Establish Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Work in established rib patt over 6 sts, pm, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern over 31 sts (pattern will be repeated 3 times), pm, work in rib to end.

Cont in patt as established, keeping 6 sts each side in Twisted Ribbing and center 31 sts in Lace Pattern until Scarf meas 59" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

Work in Twisted Ribbing patt over all sts for 6 rows. Bind off all sts in patt.


FINISHING

Weave in ends. Steam or wet block scarf to open up lace pattern.
