# PREMIER®

#### SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Shown in S Size.

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Bust:** 37¼ (41, 46¼, 49¾, 53¼) (57, 62¼, 65¾, 69¼)", intended to fit with 6-8" of positive ease **Length:** 16½ (17, 18, 18½, 19½) (20, 21, 21½, 22½)"

### MATERIALS

**Premier<sup>®</sup> Yarns** *Little Bunny™ Multi* (100% Polyester; 2.8oz/80g, 87yds/80m)

MC: 2111-06 Pastel – 4 (5, 6, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10, 11) balls

**Premier<sup>®</sup> Yarns** *Little Bunny*<sup>™</sup> (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

CC: 2079-15 Iris – 2 (3, 3, 3, 4) (4, 4, 5, 5) balls

**Hook:** US Size L-11 (8 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

9 sts x 12 rows = 4" in single crochet **Save time, check your gauge.** 

### Skills/techniques used in pattern:

- Single crochet and chain stitches.
- Decreasing.
- Sewing seams using whipstitch.

### **STITCH GUIDE**

**Stripe Sequence** (any number of sts) **Rows 1-2:** With CC, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Rows 3-6:** With MC, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rep Rows 1-6 for patt.

### **PATTERN NOTES**

This striped pullover is worked in pieces and seamed together. When changing colors, do not break yarn. Carry unused color loosely up the side. When switching colors, work the final step of the sc of a row in the new color.

### SWEATER Front

With CC, ch 43 (47, 53, 57, 61) (65, 71, 75, 79). **Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 42 (46, 52, 56, 60) (64, 70, 74, 78) sc. Counts as Row 1 of **Stripe Sequence**. Work Rows 2-6 of **Stripe Sequence**, then rep Rows 1-6 until piece meas 10½ (11, 12, 11¾, 12¾) (13¼, 13½, 14, 15)", ending with any even numbered row.

### Shape Left Front Neck

Note: continue to follow Stripe Sequence throughout remainder of Front. Row 1 (Dec): Ch 1, sc in first 18 (20, 23, 25, 27) (29, 32, 34, 36) sc, sc2tog, sc in next st, turn, leaving rem 21 (23, 26, 28, 30) (32, 35, 37, 39) Right Front sts unworked. 20 (22, 25, 27, 29) (31, 34, 36, 38) sts rem for Left Front. Row 2: Work even in Stripe Sequence. Row 3 (Dec): Ch 1, sc in each sc to last 3 sc, sc2tog, sc in last sc, turn – 1 st dec'd. Row 4: Work even in Stripe Sequence. Rep Rows 3-4, 7 (7, 7, 8, 8) (8, 9, 9, 9) more times - 12 (14, 17, 18, 20) (22, 24, 26, 28) sts rem for Shoulder. Work even, if necessary, until piece meas 161/2 (17, 18, 181/2, 191/2) (20, 21, 21½, 22½)" from beginning edge, ending with any even numbered row. Fasten off.

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### V-Neck Crochet Pullover

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13<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> (14<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>, 15, 16, 17) (17<sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>, 19<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>, 20<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>, 21<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>)"

> 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17) (17, 17½, 17½, 18)"

### **Right Front Neck**

Join yarn to the st next to the final st worked of Row 1 Left Front.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc2tog, sc in each sc to end, turn -1 st dec'd.

### Row 2: Work even in Stripe Sequence.

**Row 3 (Dec):** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in each sc to end, turn – 1 st dec'd.

Row 4: Work even in Stripe Sequence.

Rep Rows 3-4, 7 (7, 7, 8, 8) (8, 9, 9, 9) more times – 12 (14, 17, 18, 20) (22, 24, 26, 28) sts rem for Shoulder. Work even, if necessary, until piece meas 16½ (17, 18, 18½, 19½) (20, 21, 21½, 22½)" from beginning edge, ending with any even numbered row. Fasten off.

### Back

Work as for Front, excluding Neck Shaping, until piece meas 16½ (17, 18, 18½, 19½) (20, 21, 21½, 22½)" and the same number of rows have have been worked as Front.

#### **Sleeves**

With CC, ch 21 (21, 23, 23, 23) (25, 25, 25, 27). **Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 20 (20, 22, 22, 22) (24, 24, 24, 26) sc. Counts as Row 1 of **Stripe Sequence**. Work Rows 2-4 of **Stripe Sequence**.

*Note: continue to follow Stripe Sequence throughout remainder of Sleeves.* 

**Inc row:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn -2 sts inc'd.

Rep Inc row every 6 (4, 6, 4, 4) (4, 4, 2, 2) rows, 1 (0, 4, 1, 3) (3, 9, 1, 0) more time(s), then rep Inc row

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every 8 (6, 8, 6, 6) (6, 0, 4, 4) rows, 3 (5, 1, 5, 4) (4, 0, 9, 10) time(s) – 30 (32, 34, 36, 38) (40, 44, 46, 48) sts. Continue to work even in **Stripe Sequence** with no further incs until piece meas 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17) (17, 17½, 17½, 18)", ending with any even numbered row. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements. Whipstitch shoulders together. Whipstitch Sleeves to body. Whipstitch Sleeve and side seams.


### **Neck Edging**

**Rnd 1:** With CC, work 18 (18, 18, 20, 20) (20, 22, 22, 22) sc along Back Neck edge, 1 sc for each row along Left Front to last row, sc2tog (last row of Left Front together with first row of Right Front), work 1 sc for each row along Right Front, join with sl st to beg sc. **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, loosely sl st in each sc around. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
