

Little Bunny Toy

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Height: 61/2" (not including ears)

### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Little Bunny (100% Polyester; 3.5oz/100 g, 109yds/100m)

• 2079-01 White – 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) dpns, or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker, safety eyes or smooth black yarn for embroidering, smooth pink yarn for nose, polyester stuffing

#### **GAUGE**

14 sts x 20 rnds = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

# Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- · Knit front and back increases.
- Knit 2 together and slip, slip knit decreases.
- Small circumference knitting in the round.
- Picking up stitches.
- Embroidering and attaching safety eyes.
- Working with textured yarns.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This toy is worked from the bottom up in the round. For safety purposes, it is recommended to embroider the eyes instead of using safety eyes for young children and babies that may chew on the toy.

#### TOY

#### Base

Cast on 4 sts, pm and join for working in the rnd, careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: [Kfb] 4 times – 4 sts inc'd, 8 sts total.

Even Rnds 2-8: Knit.

Rnd 3: [Kfb] 8 times – 8 sts inc'd, 16 sts total.

Rnd 5: \*Kfb, k1; rep from \* to end – 8 sts inc'd, 24 sts total.

Rnd 7: \*Kfb, k2; rep from \* to end – 8 sts inc'd, 32 sts total.

Rnd 9: \*Kfb, k3; rep from \* to end – 8 sts inc'd, 40 sts total.

Rnd 10: Purl.

# Body

Work even in St st until piece measures 5" from Rnd 10 from previous section.

# **Shape Head**

**Rnd 1:** \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 sts dec'd, 32 sts rem.

Even Rnds 2-6: Knit.

**Rnd 3:** \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 sts dec'd, 24 sts rem.

At this point, partially stuff Toy and using photos as a guide, add eyes 4" up from Rnd 10 of Base and 1½" apart and embroider nose, centered 1" below eyes.

**Rnd 5:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.

Rnd 7: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end – 8 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.

**Rnd 8:** Rep Rnd 7 – 4 sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, finish stuffing Toy. Thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts, pull tight to close.

# **FINISHING**

#### **Ears**

On top/side of Head,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " up diagonally from eye (use picture as a guide), pick up and knit 6 sts. Work even in Garter st for  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

**Row 1:** Ssk, k2, k2tog – 2 sts dec'd.

Even Rows 2-4: Knit.

Row 3: Ssk, k2tog – 2 sts dec'd.

**Row 5:** K2tog, cut yarn and pull end through to bind

off last st.

Rep for other Ear.

Weave in ends.

# **Abbreviations**

dec('d) decrease(d)

**Garter st** Knit every row.

inc('d) increase(d)

**k** knit

**kfb** knit into the front and back of the next st

(1 st inc'd)

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
RS right side
pm place marker

ssk slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
