

Loopy Fringed Scarf

Level: Intermediate



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width at center (excluding fringe): 13"

Length: 52"

MATERIALS

Premier Yarns[®] Sweet Roll[™] (100% acrylic; 140 gm/ 245 yds)

- #1047-12 Frosty Swirl – 2 balls

Needles: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Garter St

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTE

This scarf begins at one end, widens toward the center, then tapers to the other end. The last 5 sts of each RS row will be unraveled when the knitting is complete to make fringe.

SCARF

Cast on 7 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K5, place marker, p1 tbl, k1.

Row 2 (RS): Knit to 1 st before marker, m1, k1 tbl, sl marker, knit to end – 1 st increased.

Row 3: Knit to marker, sl marker, p1 tbl, knit to end.

Row 4: Knit to 1 st before marker, k1 tbl, sl marker, knit to end.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Rep Rows 2-5 until there are 55 sts total; 50 sts before the marker and 5 sts after the marker with RS facing.

Row 6 (RS): Knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1tbl, sl marker, knit to end – 1 st decreased.

Row 7: Rep Row 3.

Row 8: Rep Row 4.

Row 9: Rep Row 3.

Rep Rows 6-9 until there are 7 sts total; 2 sts before marker and 5 sts after marker with RS facing.

Bind off 1 st. Cut yarn and draw tail through st on right hand needle.

FINISHING

Slip remaining sts off needle. Unravel these sts all the way to the cast on row, creating loops of fringe along

one edge of the scarf.

Working with a pair of loops held together, tie an overhand knot, snugging the knot up against the edge of the scarf. Continue for each pair of loops along edge.

Weave in ends.

Block gently.

Abbreviations

k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
m1	make 1
p	purl
RS	Right Side
rep	repeat
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through back loop
WS	Wrong Side
