



Vector Shawl

Level: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 54"

Length at center: 21½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Luna (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 100g/273yds)

- #1072-07 Mars – 2 balls

Needles: US Size 6 (4mm) circular needle 24" long, *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts and 36 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

For this design, the position of the markers and the increases is important. Through Row 84, there is a marker on either side of a single center stitch. The increases are placed "outside" the markers. This makes the stripes turn at a 90 degree angle. From Row 85 to the end, the increases are placed "inside" the markers, so the number of stitches between the markers grows by 2 every other row. This change rounds off the corner at the center of the shawl.

In addition to the increases in the center of the shawl, there is an increase 2 stitches away from each edge every other row.

SHAWL

Cast on 7 sts.

Row 1: K2, yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, k2 – 11 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K2, yo, knit to marker, yo, sl marker, k1, sl marker, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2 – 4 sts increased.

Row 4: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 40 more times – 175 sts.

Row 85: K2, yo, knit to marker, sl marker, yo, knit to marker, yo, sl marker, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2 – 4 sts increased.

Row 86: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 25 more times – 279 sts.

Row 137: Knit.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Block to finished measurements.
