



# Mesh Tunic

Level: Intermediate

## SIZES

Women's Small (Medium, Large, Extra Large, 2X)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 36 (40, 44, 48, 52)''

**Length:** 24 (24, 25, 25½, 26½)''

## MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Everyday® Soft Worsted* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113 g/203 yds)

- #ED100-01 Snow White – 3 (3, 3, 3, 3) balls

**Needles:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

12 sts x 7 rows = 4'' in dc

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

### Mesh

**Row 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), \*skip 1 st, dc in next st\*\*, ch 1; rep from \* across, ending with \*\*, turn.

Rep Row 1 for pattern.

### FRONT AND BACK (make 2)

Ch 56 (62, 68, 74, 80).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—55 (61, 67, 73, 79) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 3-4:** Rep Row 2.

Work in mesh pattern until piece measures 16 (16, 16½, 16½, 17)'' from beginning. Do not fasten off.

## Sleeves

**Next row:** Ch 12, dc in 5th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1), continue in mesh pattern to end, turn – 31 (34, 37, 40, 43) ch-1 sp; 32 (35, 38, 41, 44) dc.

**Next row:** Ch 12, dc in 5th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1), continue in mesh pattern to end, turn – 35 (38, 41, 44, 47) ch-1 sp; 36 (39, 42, 45, 48) dc.

Work even in mesh patt until piece measures 7½ (7½, 8, 8½, 9)'' from beginning of sleeves.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, sc in each st to end, turn.

Rep last row once more. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Sleeve Edging

Join yarn along cuff edge, sc evenly across, turn.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Rep on opposite sleeve.

### Tunic Edging

Work 1 row sc evenly along side and underarm edges. Holding front and back pieces with wrong sides together, join at sides, underarms and shoulders by working sl st through inner loops of each sc edge, leaving center 10 (10, 10½, 11, 11½)'' open for neck along top edge. Weave in ends. Block lightly.
