

Minikins Elephant

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height: 5"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Minikins ${ }^{T M}$ (50\% Acrylic, 50\% Cotton; $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g}, 158 \mathrm{yds} / 145 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- A: 2103-28 Chambray -1 ball
- B: 2103-01 White -1 ball
- C: 2103-42 Black-1 ball

Hook: US Size B-1 ( 2.25 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, stuffing

## GAUGE

24 sts $\times 24$ rnds $=4$ " before stuffing Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitch.
- Magic ring.
- Invisible single crochet decrease.
- Seaming.


## STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a $6^{\prime \prime}$ tail. Insert hk under both strands and pull up a lp. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease): Insert hk in front lp only of each of next 2 sts, yo and draw through both sts, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk ( 1 st dec'd).

## PATTERN NOTES

Join with slip stitch to first stitch unless otherwise indicated. When working in continuous rounds, place a marker in first stitch to indicate beginning of the round. Move marker up as each round begins.

## ELEPHANT

## Body

With A, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 8 sc in ring, do not join, work in continuous rnds -8 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 16 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc .
Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 32 sc.
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around -40 sc .
Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 48 sc.
Rnds 7-12: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 13: *Sc in next 6 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 42 sc .
Rnds 14-15: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 16: *Sc in next 5 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 36 sc.
Rnds 17-18: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 19: *Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 30 sc .
Rnds 20-21: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 22: *Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 24 sc .
Rnds 23-24: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 25: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff Body firmly.

## project continued

## Head

With A, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds -8 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 16 .
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 32 sc .
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 40 sc .
Rnds 6-12: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 13: *Sc in next 8 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 36 sc.

Rnd 14: *Sc in next 7 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 32 sc.

Rnd 15: *Sc in next 6 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 28 sc .

Rnd 16: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 17: *Sc in next 5 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 18: *Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 20 sc.

Rnd 19: Sc in each st around.
Stuff Head firmly.
Rnd 20: *Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around 16 sc . Do not fasten off.

## Trunk

Note: The Trunk will begin with back and forth short rows joined to Rnd 20 of Head and then proceed in continuous rounds to complete the length; read pattern before beginning this section. Stuff the Trunk as pattern progresses.

Row 1: Cont from Head, sc in next 4 sts, sl st in next st (not a counted st) leaving rem sts unworked, turn - 4 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1 (not a st), sk first sl st, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sk 1 st on Rnd 20, sl st in next unworked st on Rnd 20 (not a counted st), turn 6 sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, sk sl st, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sk 1 st on Rnd 20, sl st in next unworked st on Rnd 20, do not turn-8 sc.
Note: Trunk pattern continues in rnds from this point forward.
Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same st as sl st, sc in next 7 sts across Rnd 20, sc in next 8 sts around Row 3; do not join, work in continuous rnds -16 sc .
Rnd 5: (Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec) 2 times, sc in each st around - 14 sc .
Rnd 6: (Sc in next st, inv-dec) 2 times, sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnds 7-10: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 11: *Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 10 sc

Rnds 12-17: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 18: Working in the blo, sc in next 9 sts, sl st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff Trunk.
Thread tapestry needle and close last rnd.

## Arms (make 2)

With A, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds-6 sc.
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc .

Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.

Rnds 4-7: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 8: *Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around-12 sc.
Rnds 9-11: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 12: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 9 sc.

Rnds 13-14: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 15: *Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around-6 sc.
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Stuff end of Arm firmly.
Legs (make 2)
With A, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds -6 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc .

Rnds 4-7: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 8: *Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around-12 sc.
Rnds 9-13: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 14: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 9 sc.

Rnds 15-16: Sc in each st around.
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Stuff end of Leg firmly.
Ears (make 2)
Front
With B, create a Magic Ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds -6 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc .

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc .
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 30 sc .
Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 36 sc .
Fasten off.

## Back

With $B$, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds -6 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc .
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 30 sc .
Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 36 sc .
Rnd 7: Place the Front and Back WS together and working through Front and Back stitches together, *sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around -42 sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Pinch ear and sew 4 sts together.

## FINISHING

Using photo as a guide, sew on Ears, Arms and Legs. Stitch on Eyes and Eyebrows with C. Add a small
embroidery running stitch with $B$ for eye detail.
Stitch nails on end of Arms with B.
Cut 4-3" lengths of yarn in A. Fold strand in half, using Rnd 1 sts on top center of Head, pull center of strands through st, pull end of strands through center lp and pull tight. Rep evenly around. Trim evenly.

Tail
Join A around any post in lower back center of Body, ch 4 . Fasten off and trim to $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ length.

Weave in ends.
