

## Minikins Bouquet

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Sunflower: $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ wide
Daisy: $3^{\prime \prime}$ wide
Rose: $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide
Budding Flower: 2" high

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Minikins ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (50\% Acrylic, 50\%
Cotton; $1.750 z / 50 \mathrm{~g}, 158 \mathrm{yds} / 145 \mathrm{~m})$

- A: 2013-33 Nutmeg - 1 ball
- B: 2013-12 Butter - 1 ball
- C: 2103-01 White - 1 ball
- D: 2103-06 Sherbet - 1 ball
- E: 2103-07 Petal-1 ball

Hook: US Size B-1 ( 2.25 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, stuffing, floral wire - 20 gauge, floral tape

## GAUGE

24 sc $\times 24$ rnds $=4$ " before stuffing
Save time, check your gauge.
Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, slip stitch, single, half double and double crochet stitches.
- Magic Ring.
- Single crochet invisible decrease.
- Single crochet 2 stitches together.
- Seaming.


## STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a $6^{\prime \prime}$ tail. Insert hk under both strands and pull up a lp. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn
tail.
Picot: ch 3 , sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hk.

## Inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease):

 Insert hk in front lp only of each of next 2 sts, yo and draw through both sts, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk ( 1 st dec'd).
## PATTERN NOTES

When working in continuous rounds, place a marker in first stitch to indicate beginning of the round. Move marker up as each round begins.

## SUNFLOWER (make 3) <br> Front

With A, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in
continuous rnds -6 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc .
Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc.
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 36 sc.
Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.
Fasten off.

## Back

Rep Rnds 1-6 of Front. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Petals

Rnd 1: Join B in any st on Rnd 7 of Front with a sl st, *ch 2, (2 tr, picot, 2 tr) in next st , ch 2, sl
st in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to first st. Fasten off.

## Assembly

Thread tapestry needle with A and sew Front to Back, stuffing before closing.

## DAISY (make 5)

## Center

With B, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 8 sc in ring, join with sl st to first st -8 sc .
Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, join with sl st to first st - 16 sc.
Fasten off.

## Petals

Join C with sl st in any st from Rnd 2 of Center, *ch 7, sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hk, dc in next 5 chs, sl st in next st on Center; rep from * around, join with sl st to first st 16 petals.

ROSE (make 2 in $D$ and 3 in E)
Ch 61.
Row 1: Dc in $6^{\text {th }}$ ch from hk, sk 2 chs, *(dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch; rep from * across, turn.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 5 dc in next ch-3 sp, *sk 1 dc , sl st in space between last skipped dc and next st, 6 dc in next ch 3 sp ; rep from * across, ending with (5 dc, ch $2, \mathrm{sl}$ st) in last ch-3 sp, do not turn.
Note: Row 3 will be worked on foundation ch, not across Row 2.
Row 3: Ch 1, working along foundation ch, sc in next 20 chs, dc in each remaining ch across.
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Roll strip starting with sc end from Row 3 in center in
a spiral flower and sew to secure.
BUDDING FLOWER (make 1)
With D, create a Magic Ring.
Rnd 1: 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds -8 sc .
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around - 16 sc
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around- 32 sc.
Rnds 5-13: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 14: *Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnds 15-16: Sc in each st around.
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Stuff firmly. Thread tapestry needle with long tail and using photo a a guide, sew opening closed.

## FINISHING

## All Flowers

Weave in ends. Insert floral wire in back center of flower and fold wire in half, twist at flower base to secure. Fold wire ends up 1". Beg at base of flower, wrap wire with floral tape.
